**Summary List of Primary School Organisation
Consultation Proposals**

Introduction

This document sets out on a school-by-school basis the proposed effects of the school organisation review to be considered by Cabinet on 30 January 2008.

The references to “filters” in the table below are to the various tables in the main report, where schools were removed from further consideration in the review because they met one or more of the criteria for the sustainable network.

References to “Stages” refer to stages in the Procedure for Consideration of School Organisation Proposals (Appendix C to the report). Stage 1 refers to those schools which were excluded from further consideration after initial discussions with the Acting Director and Cabinet member, usually because a nearby school was considered to meet the criteria for closure more closely. Stage 3 refers to schools which were excluded from further consideration in discussions with the Cabinet Member for Children and Young People’s Services after the investigation stage. More details on the reasons for these exclusions will be included in area by area consultation documents (see appendix D).

It should be noted that the alternative schools listed are those at which it is proposed that pupils could be guaranteed places. Other schools can be considered during consultation, and parents would be free to apply for any available places in any school during the implementation phase.

*The main report suggests that the new Meole Brace Primary should be based on the existing infant school. It should be noted that the Governing Body of the Junior School wish there to be local consideration on whether or not the combined school should have a religious character.

Pupil Numbers and Capacities As At January 2008

The annual pupil level census took place on 17 January 2008. This has enabled data on pupil numbers and hence unfilled places to be updated. Other data will be updated in time for inclusion in school by school consultation documents. The table below shows updated pupil numbers for all schools, along with two figures for the capacity of the school, in order to explain any possible confusion.

The first figure, the maximum buildings capacity, is the number of children which the classrooms of the school can accommodate comfortably, and is based on a national formula. The second figure, the capacity based on admissions number, is a figure calculated locally by multiplying the number of children admitted to each year group by the number of years in the school. Sometimes these are the same, but usually the admissions number capacity underestimates the actual number of unfilled places.

The table also includes the percentage of unfilled places based on the buildings capacity for each school.

Amendments and Errata

In a small number of cases, information has been mis-transcribed from the data used to inform the discussion with the Cabinet member to the final report. Although none of this data materially affects the proposals, where it has been brought to the attention of officers, it has been included below. In addition, a number of school governors or members of the public have questioned some of the data on individual schools, including that some data relates to the 2007 returns.

Paragraph 2.4 of the main report and the introduction to Appendix A both make it clear that while pupil number data was updated with January 2008 figures, other data would be updated in the School by school consultation documents, as this would be the data on which the consultation would take place. There have also been a number of assertions that the data in the report is wrong when the respondent disagrees with the interpretation. No attempt has been made to answer these points here, as these are rightly matters for discussion during the consultation period.
