

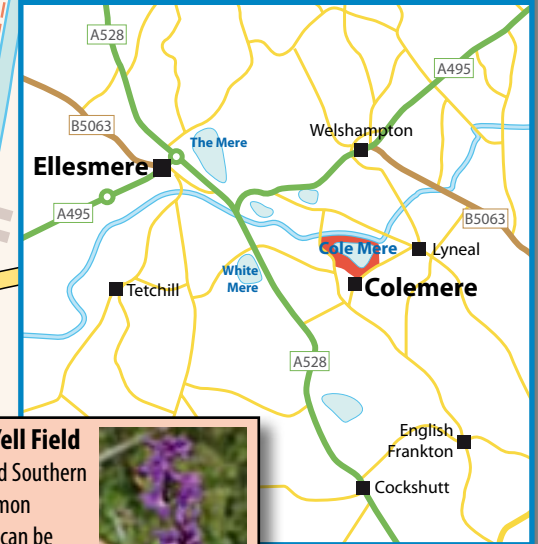
# Colemere Countryside Site

Several thousand Southern Marsh and Common Spotted Orchids can be seen flowering here in June. Grazing later in the year with cattle helps these and other important plants to survive.
