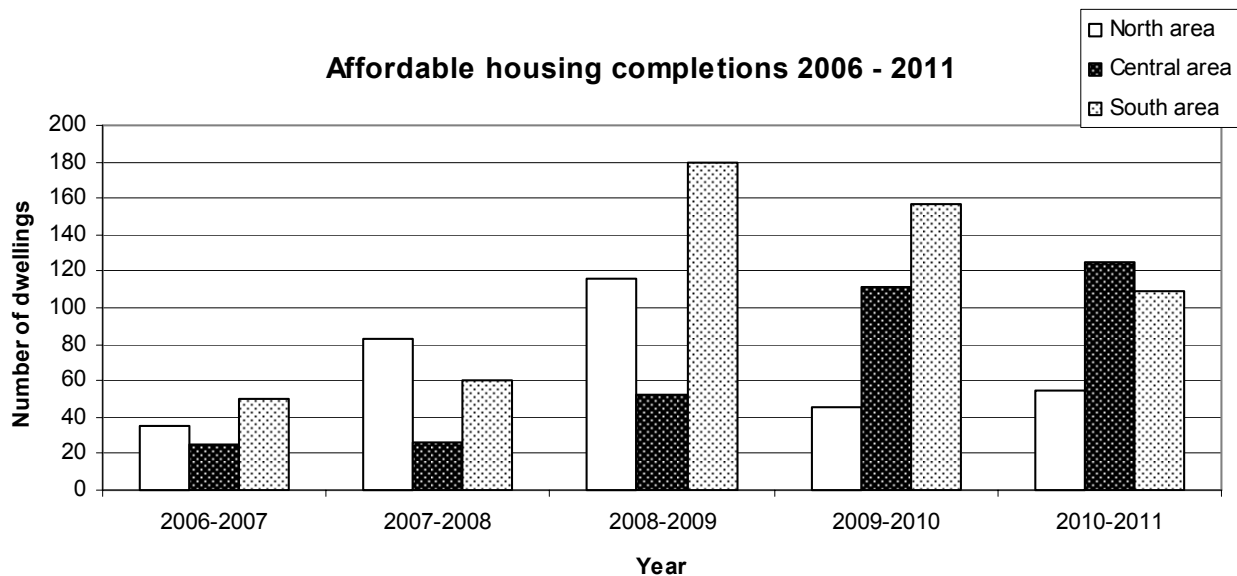

Outstanding affordable housing permissions & allocations as at April 2011

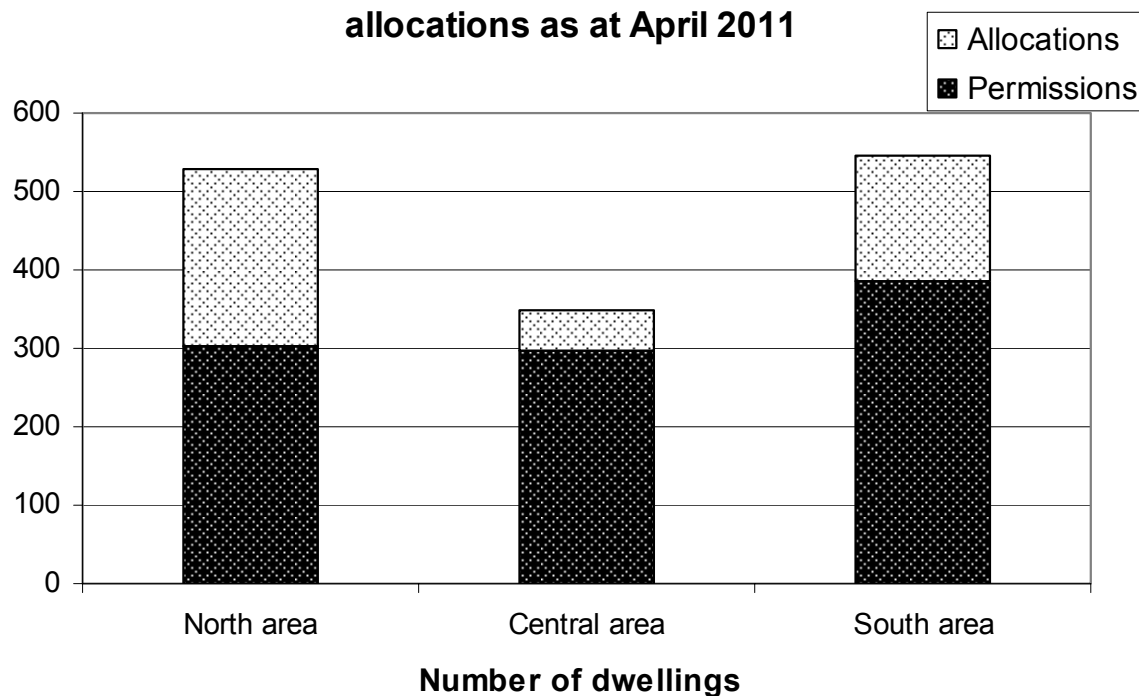

Note: Affordable housing is those houses with a tenure of local authority, housing association or other public. From 2002/03 they also include houses identified by district councils as low cost or affordable subject to Section 106 agreements. It can include social-rented housing and intermediate housing.

The figures are based on affordable housing coming through the planning system and are, therefore, lower than the total numbers added to the affordable housing stock over the years, e.g. it does not include transfer of dwelling ownership to a RSL (registered social landlord).

The figures for allocations are indicative only and can change when planning permissions are received.
