## CIEH Level 2 Award in Food Safety in Catering - Update

**Who is it for?**

The course is designed for anyone who has already achieved a level 2 award in Food Safety in Catering dated within the last three years and need to update their food hygiene knowledge to ensure they are working in accordance with current law and accepted good practice.

**Entry:** Only delegates who have achieved a CIEH Foundation

**Requirements:** Certificate in Food Hygiene or an equivalent qualification from another awarding body e.g. RIPHH, RSPH, SOFHT within the last 3 years

**Course content:**

**Hazards** – Identifying hazards within food safety

**Controls** – Dealing with issues of prevention and control

**Legal Compliance** – Dealing with the principles of food safety legislation and key legal requirements

**Outcome:** The overall objective is to remind delegates of the importance of working in a hygienic manner, to ensure they prevent contamination and protect consumers from food poisoning. Delegates are familiar with key aspects of current legislation, good practice and food safety issues.

**Length of programme:** ½ day
