

### **What are the conditions of use?**

### **Can I plug my laptop into a power socket?**

You will need to have had your equipment tested by a qualified electrician who will issue you with a Portable Appliance Test (PAT) certificate.

### **How do I connect?**

You will need a laptop with a suitable operating system and an enabled wireless card. It should automatically find the wireless frequency and offer to connect you.

### **What are the manual settings?**

If your laptop does not automatically find the network, please enter or check the following settings:

SSID SCCWEB

CHANNEL 6

WEP 64-bit

KEY SHIRE (in capitals) [or 53 48 49 52 45]

BANDWIDTH 256K up / 512K down ADSL

The internet feed is firewalled for safety but you should always ensure that your anti-virus software is up to date.
