

REVIEW OF PREMISES LICENCE UNDER THE LICENSING ACT 2003

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT Shropshire Council has received an application for the review of the above Premises Licence, pursuant to Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003.

Interested parties (persons living or involved in a business within the vicinity) and responsible authorities may make representations in writing to the Licensing Team Leader, Shropshire Council, Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury SY2 6ND between **22 April 2011 and 19 May 2011**.

A review of Licence has been requested by persons involved in business in the vicinity of the premises on the grounds that the premises operates in such a manner as to undermine the licensing objectives concerning the prevention of public nuisance.

Details of the grounds for review may be inspected at the licensing office (address as below) between the hours of 08:30am and 05:00pm Monday to Friday.

It is an offence under Section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003, knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for the offence is up to level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
