**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 14 (PART) PARISH OF FORD)  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018**

This Order is made by the Shropshire Council (“the Council”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the Council that in the interests of the Public the line of the way should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A (2) of the Wildlife Countryside Act 1981 (“the 1981 Act”) because it appears to the authority that the Shropshire definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53 (3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The public right of way over the land situated at The Leasowes and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date that the Council certifies that works have been carried out to bring the site of the new footpath described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order into a fit condition for use by the public and thereupon the Shropshire definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it the public right of way to be stopped up.

2. Notwithstanding paragraph 1 of this Order statutory undertakers shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 above, namely: where immediately before the date on which the bridleway is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same right in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

3. There shall on the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situated at Ford Village Hall described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken lines on the map contained in this Order and thereupon the Shropshire definitive map shall be modified by adding that path to it.

3A. The Shropshire definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this order.

4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

#### **Description of site of existing path or way**

that part of Footpath 14 in the Parish of Ford leaving point A on the Order Map at SJ 4151 1356 running in a general south westerly direction through the property of number 1 The Leasowes then the gardens of numbers 2, 32, 31, 30 and 29 The Leasowes to the County Road and point B on the Order Map at SJ 4145 1348; a total distance of approximately 101 metres

#### **Description of site of new path or way**

leaving But Lane at point A on the Order Map (SJ 4151 1356) running in a general WSW then SSW direction on a surfaced path to The Leasowes at point C on the Order Map (SJ 4144 1352); a total distance of approximately 90 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.
