




No waiting at any time

along the edge of the road mean you can't wait during the times shown on the sign.

However you may stop while passengers get into or out of the vehicle and to load and unload, *unless* there are also loading restrictions.



No waiting during the times shown on the sign

Please note that yellow line parking restrictions apply to the whole of the highway on the side that they are marked, including any footway or verge.

Therefore, parking on a footway or verge next to a yellow line can result in a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) being issued.

Loading restrictions

Loading restrictions

are shown by yellow lines on the kerb or at the edge of the carriageway. They indicate that loading or unloading is prohibited during the times shown



No loading or unloading at any time



No loading or unloading during the times shown on the sign

Double yellow lines on the


on the signs.

kerb mean no loading or unloading at any time. A single yellow line means no loading or unloading during the specified times shown.

Loading bays

Are white bays marked with the words 'Loading only' and a sign with the white and blue trolley symbol.

A sign will show the times when the bay can be used and whether loading and unloading is restricted to certain types of goods vehicles. Vehicles may not



Pay & Display parking bays

In the Shropshire Council area, if you only wish to park for up to 15 minutes, you do not need to buy a ticket. Otherwise, you must purchase a Pay & Display ticket that covers the period you wish to park. This is indicated on the ticket. You must ensure that the ticket is clearly displayed. At the end of the permitted parking period you must leave the parking space and cannot return within the time period shown on the ticket machine. Purchasing and displaying another pay

and display ticket without leaving the parking space for the required period is not permitted.


Always display the correct ticket, voucher, permit or badge

Parking bays for specific users

You must not park in parking spaces reserved for specific users such as Blue Badge holders, taxis, coaches or residents, unless you are entitled to do so.
