2011 Census - Total Population

Nationally - The Census shows that the population of England & Wales has now reached 56,075,912. This is an increase of 7.8% since the 2001 Census when the population was 49,138,831.

Locally - The 2011 Census shows Shropshire has a population of 306,129, this is an increase of 8.1% from the 2001 Census count of 283,173.


The 2011 Census results provide valuable data for the first time on the current Electoral Wards in Shropshire, adopted in 2009. This means it is not possible to make historical comparisons with the Electoral Wards used in the 2001 Census. The Electoral Ward with the largest population is Bayston Hill, Column and Sutton with 11,982. This equates to 3.9% of the total population for Shropshire. The Electoral Ward with the lowest population is Chirbury and Worthen with 3,049. This equates to 1.0% of the total population for Shropshire.
