

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP  
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATHS UN1 (PART),  
PARISH OF WEM RURAL) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2015**

The above named order made on 20<sup>th</sup> August 2015 by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert

the full width of that part of Footpath UN1 Wem Rural, from point A on the Order Map (SJ 5230 2847) where it leaves Weir Lane, passing in front of Weir Cottage and running in a general westerly direction to meet a footbridge at point B on the Order Map (SJ 5222 2846); a total distance of approximately 94 metres; **onto a line** from a pedestrian gate at point A on the Order Map (SJ 5230 2847) where it leaves Weir Lane, running in a general NNW direction for approximately 14 metres, then following the bank of the River Roden in a general westerly direction to meet the footbridge at point B on the Order Map (SJ 5222 2846); a total distance of approximately 97 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

A copy of the order and the order map and an explanatory statement have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Council offices at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours. Copies of the order and map may be bought from the Council, at the above address at a price of £6.50.

Any representations about or objections to the order may be sent in writing to the Outdoor Recreation Manager, Business Growth & Prosperity, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, SY2 6ND, or by email to [outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk](mailto:outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk) not later than 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2014. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
