

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP  
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 32 AND FOOTPATH 33 (PART), PARISH OF  
GREAT NESS) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018**

The above named order made on 17<sup>th</sup> May 2018 by the Shropshire Council (“the Council”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will **divert**

the full width of that part of Footpath 32, Great Ness, from point A on the order map (GR SJ 3706 1945), running in a general south westerly then south-south-westerly direction for approximately 608 metres to point B on the order map (GR SJ 3676 1895); and the full width of that part of Footpath 32 from point B on the order map (SJ 3676 1895) running in a general south westerly direction for approximately 151 metres to point D on order map (SJ 3665 1885), then continuing as that part Footpath 33, running in a general southerly direction for approximately 144 metres to meet point C on the order map (SJ 3663 1870); a total distance of approximately 903 metres;

**onto a line**

from point A on the order map (SJ 3706 1945) running in a general south westerly direction on a surfaced track for approximately 284 metres then continuing via a gate (GR SJ 3695 1919) in a general south westerly direction for approximately 17 metres on a natural surface, then crossing a surfaced track for approximately 3 metres before continuing in the same general south westerly direction on a natural surface for approximately 295 metres to meet a gate at point B on the order map (SJ 3676 1895); and a footpath to be created from point B on the order map (SJ 3676 1895) running in a general southerly direction on a natural surface for approximately 25 metres then continuing in a general south, then south-south-westerly then south westerly direction on a surfaced track for approximately 220 metres. It then continues to run on a natural surface for approximately 38 metres in a general south westerly direction to a gate (GR SJ 3663 1872) and then over a footbridge to meet point C (SJ3663 1870) on the order map; a total distance of approximately 882 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
