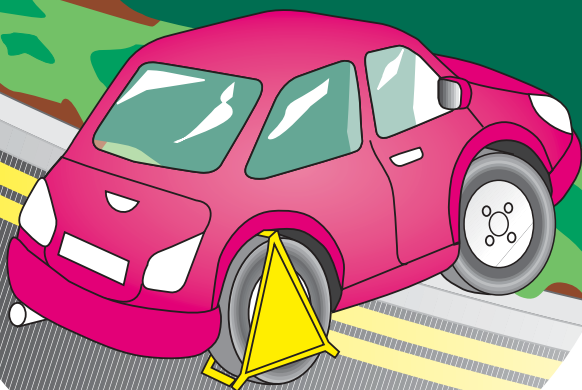

Parking at Shirehall

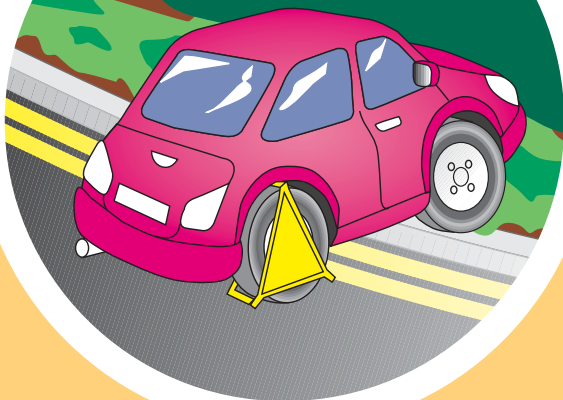
Your guide to the NEW Parking Zones

From Monday 1 March there will be new arrangements for parking at Shirehall. There will be new signs on the ground, and new staff to deal with illegal and unauthorised parking. The changes are intended to manage the car park in a better way, to encourage car sharing, and to make access to spaces easier overall.

- 1 Short-stay Parking** for staff and visitors whose business will last half an hour or less.
- 2 Car Share, Members, and Authorised Visitor Parking** for staff who have registered as car sharers; for Members; and for visiting speakers, inspectors etc who have been booked in with main reception (tel 01743 252873) by officers or Members.
- 3 Visitors' Parking** for general visitor use.

- 4 Staff Parking**, exclusively for the use of staff.
- 5 Disabled Staff Parking.**
- 6 Disabled Visitors' Parking.**
- 7 Crown Court's Parking.**





● Wheel Clamping

Along with new signs and patrols by car park security officers, contractors will be engaged to clamp cars parked incorrectly. This will include visitors parking in the **Staff Car Park**, cars left for more than half an hour in the **Short Stay Car Park**, and staff parking in the wrong place, or parking without displaying their car park permit.

The fee for removal of the clamp will be £50.

● Meetings and events

Anyone arranging a meeting or event at Shirehall should encourage visitors to car share or use other means of transport if at all possible. **Please warn** them that parking may not be available to them, especially at peak times. Staff who can car share, even for just a few days per week, will help the situation greatly. Staff can advertise on the corporate notice board under 'Travel' for partners to car share with.
