This would ensure the vision encapsulated the full scope of cultural issues and would be in keeping with Government definitions and agenda's as set out in DCMS 2004, Culture at the Heart of Regeneration, and DCMS (2006) Culture and Sustainable Communities Joint Agreement, ODPM (2005) Sustainable Communities: People, Places and Prosperity.

The amendment would be consistent with the Spatial Vision for Minerals set out in 3.1 of the Mineral Resources DPD (iii).

Ref. to sport and recreation in CP4, 4.18 and CP7 is welcomed and supported by Sport England.
