Application Determination Timescales

The County Planning Authority aims to issue a decision notice on a planning application for 'major' development within the statutory period of 13 weeks following the receipt of a valid application. 'Major' development includes applications relating to waste management or deposit, and applications for the winning and working of minerals or the use of land for mineral-working deposits.

The County Planning Authority aims to determine an application for development that is not 'major' development within the statutory 8 week timescale.

For an application that is accompanied by an Environmental Statement under the Environmental Impact Assessment regulations, the relevant determination timescale is 16 weeks.

Should it not be possible to determine the application within these timescales, the County Planning Authority may seek to agree with the applicant an extension to the determination period, to allow sufficient time to resolve any outstanding planning issues.
