## Shropshire Cricket Board County Trials for 2009 Season

Dear Masters in charge of Cricket, Heads of PE, Directors of Sport

Please find enclosed nomination forms for the forthcoming County and District trials to be held from September – December. These trials will give Managers and Coaches the opportunity to select squads for the winter training programme. As usual, age ranges will be taken from 31<sup>st</sup> August 2008 so this years U10s will be next years U11s etc.

We are currently re-structuring our junior cricket programme so squads will be selected in the following age ranges.

**Boys** Under 12s, 13s, 14s, 15s, & 16/17 **Girls** Under 11/12/13, 15 & 17 **Disability** Any age.

Shropshire Cricket Board will be running a District Cricket programme for boys Under 10s and Under 11s from 2009. This is explained in more detail in the accompanying letter.

Before making any nominations, please ensure that each child you nominate wishes to attend the trial and be considered for selection. It is not necessary to nominate current County players. **Could you also ensure you circle District Nomination or County Nomination for each player you nominate.**

Please return all nominations to Steve Aston at the Shropshire Cricket Board Office **no later Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> September.**

We are still building our list of players on our players data base, so you nominations including addresses and phone numbers etc are vital to the growth and development of Shropshire Cricket, particularly when developing additional coaching camps and festivals.

Managers will inform nominated players of details of when and where trials will be held.
