I would like to object to the change in licensing hours at the Bridgnorth Football Club on Innage Lane.

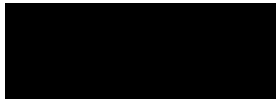

My 6 year old son's bedroom is on the rear of the house and he can be disturbed at night with the current closures. This isn't too much of a problem currently as this is usually on the weekends. I dread to think how he would feel at school on a Monday morning if the Club noise levels and drinking culture extends to a Thursday and Sunday night.

My 3 year old daughter sleeps at the front of the house. We have regularly had inebriated people causing a nuisance on the road and in the carpark with little or no police presence. There is also insufficient parking to cope with their current clientele on their carpark. The noise at closing time is loud and disturbing and will inevitably only intensify and get more frequent with the changing hours and requests for outdoor purchasing.
