We are writing in response to an application by Bridgnorth Football Club to obtain a licence for extended hours and to broadcast loud music.

We feel that notice of this application was inadequately publicised and poorly displayed (on the pavement at the base of a street lamp) It was only pointed out by a chance meeting with a neighbour and many local residents are unlikely to have seen it, especially those who live in the ten bungalows adjacent to the football club.

The prospect of extended licensing hours at a site surrounded by residential properties is totally inappropriate and is likely to cause excessive noise and nuisance late at night.

Of particular concern is the proposed freedom to broadcast regular musical recordings and live performances. During previous such events the volume has been unbearably loud requiring doors and windows to be kept closed. The prospect of more frequent such occasions, especially on warm summer nights, is not acceptable.

We feel that this is not a suitable setting for the proposed plan and sincerely hope that this application will be refused.
