AFC IS CURRENTLY OPEN UNTIL 8PM. TO EXTEND THE HOURS TO 11.30 AND LATER WILL CAUSE SERIOUS NUISANCE. CURRENTLY AT TIMES THERE ARE ROWDY INDIVIDUALS SHOUTING AND SWEARING, IF HOURS ARE EXTENDED THESE SITUATIONS WILL FURTHER DISTURB AND ANNOY MY FAMILY AND NEIGHBOURS. THESE OLD HOUSES ARE NOT SOUNDPROOF, SOUND TRAVELS THROUGH THE AIRBRICK INTO MY DAUGHTER'S ROOM AND IF LATER THIS WILL KEEP HER AWAKE, AFFECT HER SCHOOLING AND EDUCATION.

IN ADDITION, THE OVERSPILL FROM THE 15 CAR PARK SPACES AT AFC TO THE ROAD OUTSIDE BLOCKS OUR FRONTAGES, DRIVEWAYS & PAVEMENTS. EVEN EARLIER IN THE DAY, ANY EVENTS CAUSE SERIOUS OBSTRUCTION. RECENTLY SOMEONE LEFT THERE CAR ON THE ROAD FOR 2 DAYS AFTER DRINKING AT AFC WITH A WINDOW OPEN, ALARM SOUNDING AND PARTIALLY OBSTRUCTING MY DRIVE.

AFC IS TOO CLOSE TO RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES FOR SUCH LATE HOURS AND DISTURBANCE. NEIGHBOURS ARE VERY CLOSE TO THESE PREMISES WHICH SHOULD JUST BE KEPT AS A FOOTBALL CLUB WITH SOCIAL EVENTS FOR LOCAL PEOPLE AND THEIR CHILDREN, WHICH SHOULD END AND CLOSE AT THE PRESENT REASONABLE TIME.

All representations in their entirety, including your name and address, will be disclosed to the applicant for the premises licence and any other interested parties. If all parties agree, the application can be dealt with without holding a hearing.
