To support business during the 'Restart and Recovery' phase of COVID 19 the programme helped start-ups, early stage and growth businesses to access general business advice and support through business 121 sessions and various topical business webinars and events.

ARG Core – Business Boost Programme

Description

A suite of webinars has been developed to aid businesses with their learning and development which can be accessed offline through the Invest in Shropshire website. This follows feedback from Retail and Tourism sectors and will allow the businesses to access a series of webinars covering different business disciplines at the time and place of their choice and not when we are running them in real time. This was launched on 31 March 2022 and is a legacy for the SC Economic Recovery Funds. We currently have around 70 webinars available for access.

The Hub offers unparalleled support and our advisers bring expertise and knowledge across the full range of business issues from access to finance, sales and marketing to HR and Health and Safety concerns and more.

ARG Digital Hub

Description

The Digital Hub hosted a range of programmes which were centred on the 'Digital Revolution' and adopting new technologies in response to COVID 19. This was through various webinar programmes, 15 hours specialist support for addressing cyber security and attaining Cyber Essentials certification, 12 hours specialist support on adopting digital technologies and improving your digital presence as a business. Also, the delivery of a highly successful Tech Severn two-day Conference in June and working with Media Insiders to include a Podcast opportunity for 10 businesses to be showcased and released in the media sphere. This was called **Marching On!** We looked at businesses that had either been 'Born out of CVOID 19' or 'Grown your way out of COVID 19'.

Silverpreneurs® is more than just a place to find business support, it's a space for like-minded people who want to show just how good life is after 50! The programme includes three months of support delivered through a combination of 1-2-1 and group sessions where you can learn, grow and share your unique skills and experience with the group. The Silver Experts will share their business knowledge, experience and networks with you, whilst the community of Silverpreneurs® will be there to share the highs and lows of running a business, supporting and celebrating with each other along the way.

Funding and Spend

- Allocated £71,000
- Spend £71,000

Outputs/Outcomes

- Delivered three cohorts
- 45 registered for the programme **42** completed the programme which was **100**% target achieved.
- Businesses came from 24 different sectors
- 40% male, 60% female
- All businesses were from a **15 mile radius** of Shrewsbury Town Centre as the central point.
- 1 Alumni event = 29 businesses

- 4 virtual webinars = 49 businesses
- 1 Networking event and Expo (face 2 face) = 30 businesses.

Successes

- Due to demand a third cohort was added to the programme
- Created a Silverpreneurs Alumni so the group keep in touch and the first Alumni Networking Event took place in Oswestry on 30 March with further ones arranged.

ARG Spark Social

Description

Developed and delivered a Social Enterprise Conference for 2022. The Conference was centred on celebrating everything Social in Shropshire, especially given we have Social Enterprise Place status, and CSR amongst the private sector 'Purpose to Profit' and how we build that bridge between the Private Sector and Social Enterprises. This was followed up with a series of workshops to underpin the learning from the conference.

Funding and Spend

- Allocated £20,000
- Spend £20,000

Outputs/Outcomes

- The conference took place on **17 February from 10 1.30p.m.** and was delivered virtually through Yarrington who had a purpose-built studio and virtual platform to host the event, with Spark Social branding.
- The Spark Social Conference was a great success and 148 businesses and individuals joined us virtually on the day.
- Delivered **3** follow on webinars to support the conference, appetite and momentum gained.
- **45 businesses** attended the follow-on webinars centred on CSR, collaboration and partnerships.
- Worked with many businesses and social enterprises across the county whom took part in the Conference.
- The Conference will be available to watch offline for 1 year.

ARG Start Up Shropshire

Description

Providing fully funded help and mentoring for anyone in Shropshire who is starting or planning to start a new business.

The programme consists of 8 weekly masterclasses and includes mentoring meetings to meet individual needs. Seasoned, expert coaches are in place who have trodden the same path and will also introduce you to wider offerings as part of the programme.

The 8 modules cover every aspect of starting a business: Setting goals & milestones - Understanding your customers - Marketing Strategy - Creating demand - Pricing Strategy - Finance & accounting - Time management - Good relationships - Legal obligations - Creating resilience & sustainability - Structure

Funding and Spend

- Allocated £50,000
- Spend £50,000
- Programme will finish in December 2022

Outputs/Outcomes

- 76 individuals will be supported to start a new venture
- 48 currently registered
- 31 of the 48 completed the programme

ARG Oswestry Business Support Programme

- 4 business completed

- Further 17 businesses have been allocated
- **204 hours** allocated
- Met with Vernon and Ruth in August to gain update on new 'Collaborative Corner/Network Group for launching 5 October 2022.
