We would like to request a variation of our premises licence to remove existing conditions of "Public will be allowed on our premises for click and collect, to purchase for the retail shop, or attend an event" to enable the below description, AND to include an additional small outside space Infront of our doors & building as a consumption area only.(shown on plan in green pen)

Our business intends to operate as a café / food & drinks venue during the daytime and into early evening. During our opening hours and within our licensed hours, we will serve food, hot drinks & quality alcoholic drinks for onsite consumption or to purchase to take offsite. Our venue will also continue to operate as a space for events (primarily – but not exclusive to - wine tasting focussed events) – where people sign up or organise in advance to attend. Our general opening hours will remain well within our current licensed hours – with the café/food & drinks venue side of the business **primarily** operating with the following hours:

Monday – Closed

Tuesday – Closed

Wednesday – 12.30pm – 8pm

Thursday – 12.30pm – 8pm

Friday – 12.30pm – 10pm

Saturday – 12.30pm – 10pm

Sunday – Seasonal variation

These hours could be subject to change but wouldn't ever be outside of our licensed hours.

The events will also continue to take place within our current licensed hours, and we would continue to operate as we currently do with events making sure that we abide by all licensing objectives as set out in our current licence. For our events we always make sure that attendees are off the premises by 10.30pm, at which point the doors are locked.

The addition of customers being able to come onto our premises to have food & wine onsite, wouldn't change any of our licensed hour. We would continue to operate our business abiding by all our licensing conditions. We would continue to operate the click and collect and retail sale side of our business as well.

We are applying for the maximum times as per planning and shop opening times will be managed in house.

We intend to promote the four licensing objectives by following the guidance as set out below.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

CCTV As per current licence covering all licenced areas.

The Premises will have a zero tolerance to drugs policy, the Licence Holder shall display notices at the entrances to the premises advising attendees that the police will be informed if anyone is found in possession of controlled substances.

Drugs found will be placed in a suitable locked receptacle kept for that purpose. Means for securing and unlocking the receptacle will be held by the Premises Licence Holder or a nominated responsible person. A record shall be made of the date and time of the find, the person who made the find and the person who secured the found item(s). This record will be made available to any authorised authority on request.

The Premises Licence Holder shall make suitable arrangements with the police for the collection of any found items as soon as possible after they are found.

c) Public safety

We will not remove bottles later than 20:30 daily.
