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What this report is for

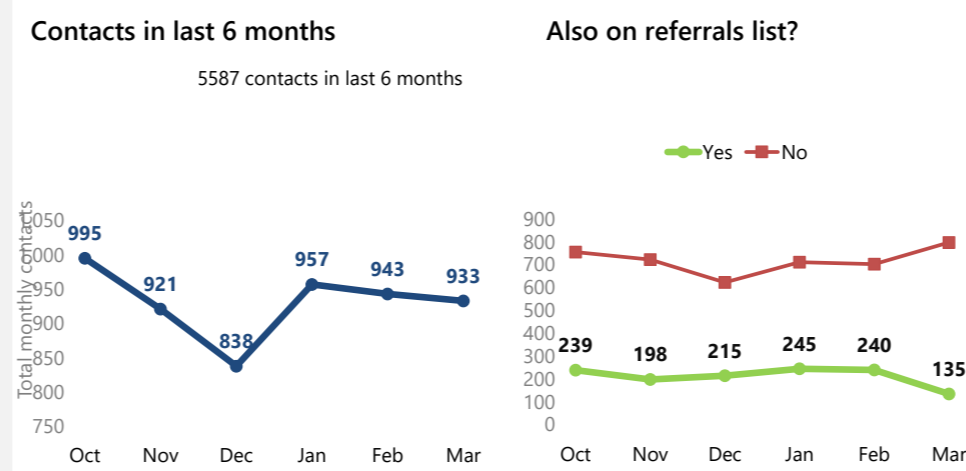

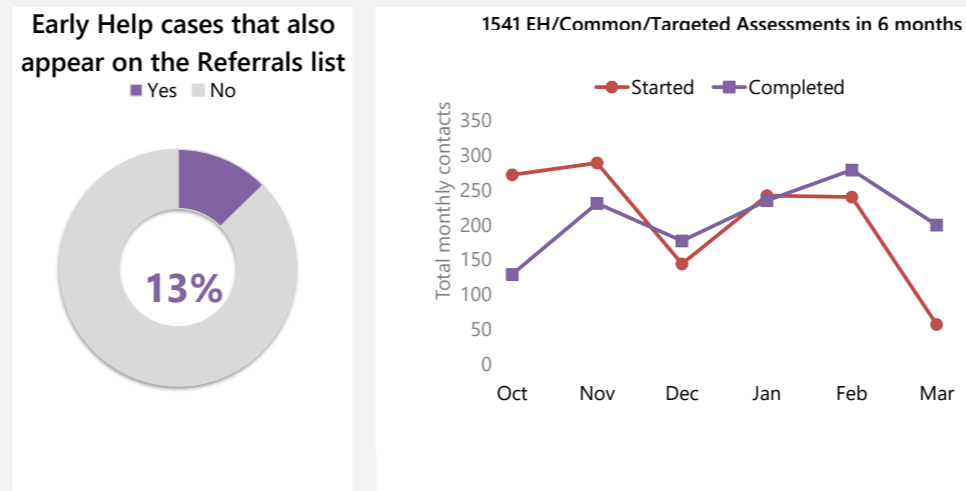

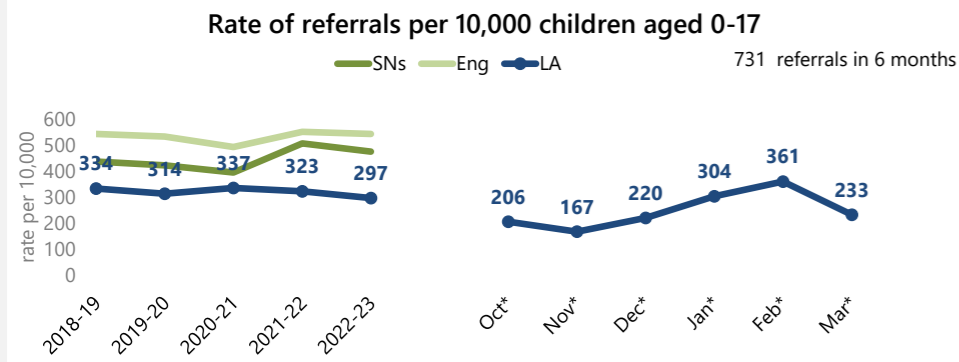


Early Help (EH) in the last 6 months

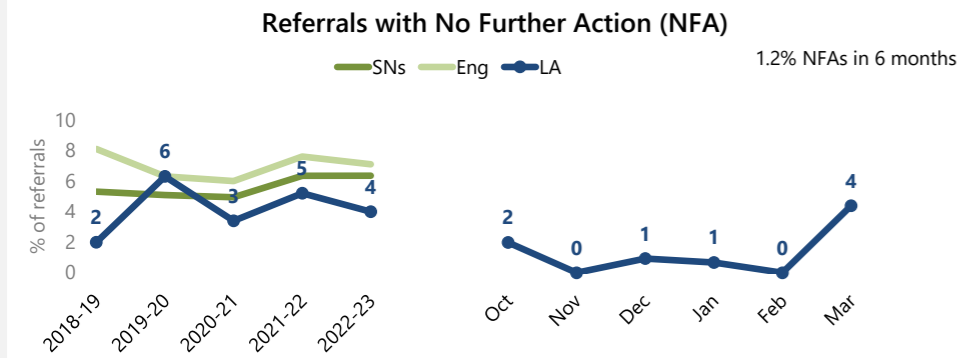

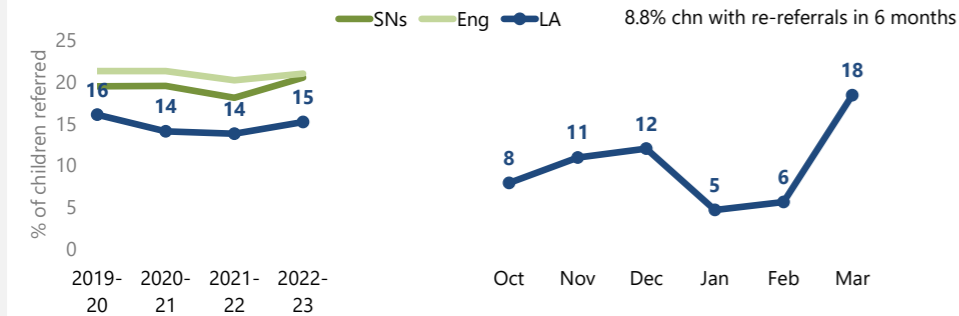
Referrals in the last 6 months

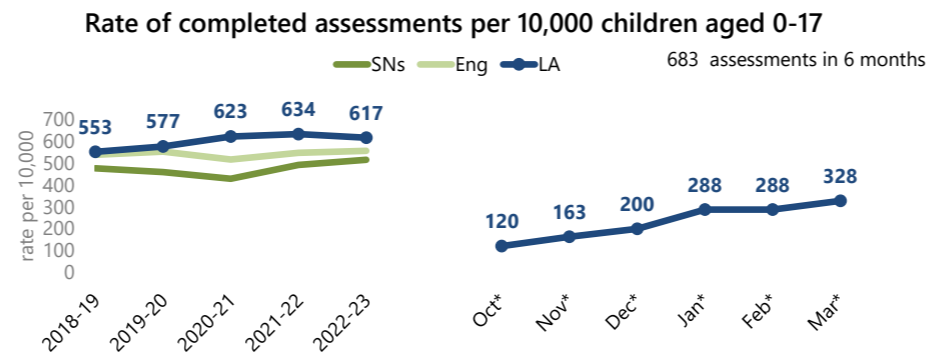

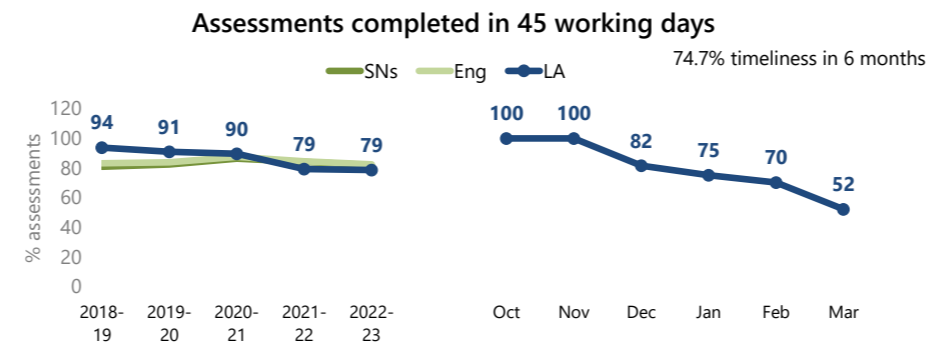

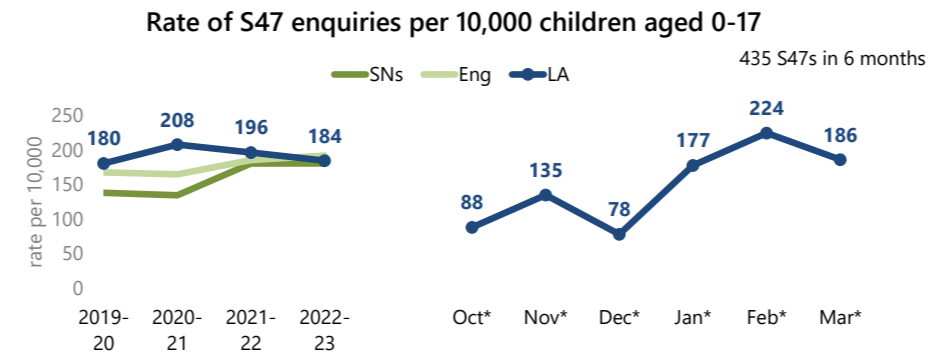

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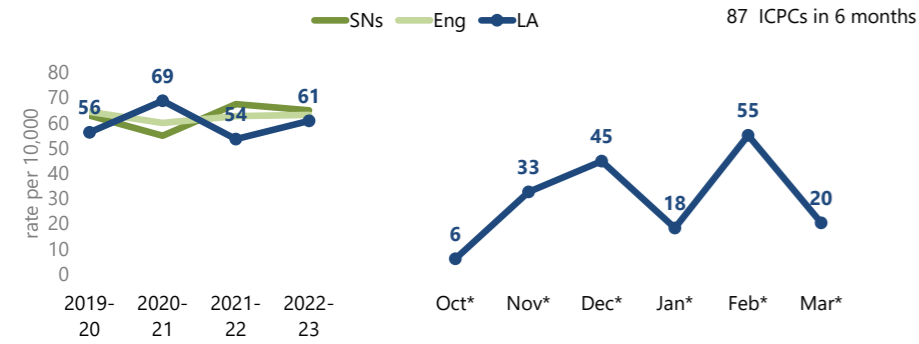

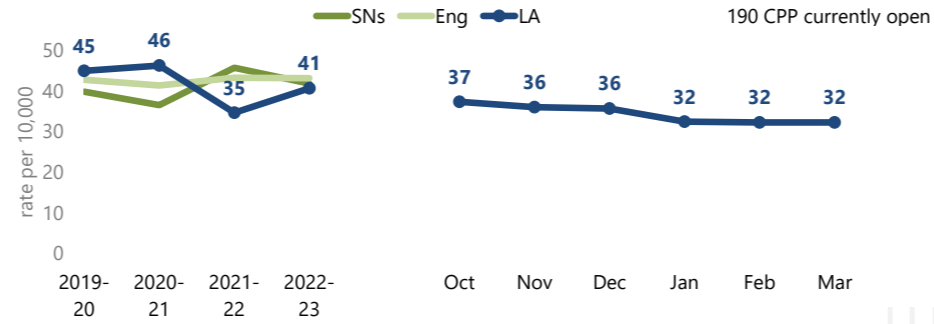
Child Protection Plans (CPP)

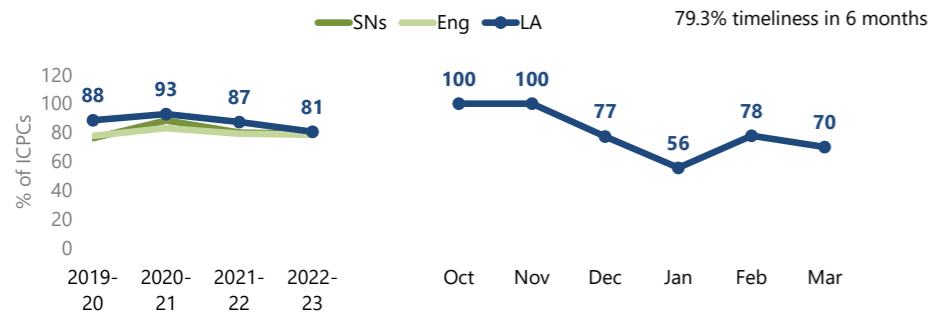
Rate of ICPCs (per 10k aged 0-17)



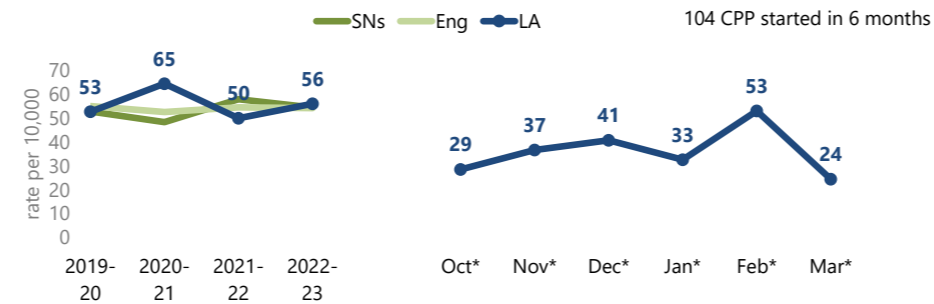
Rate of open Child Protection plans (per 10k aged 0-17)



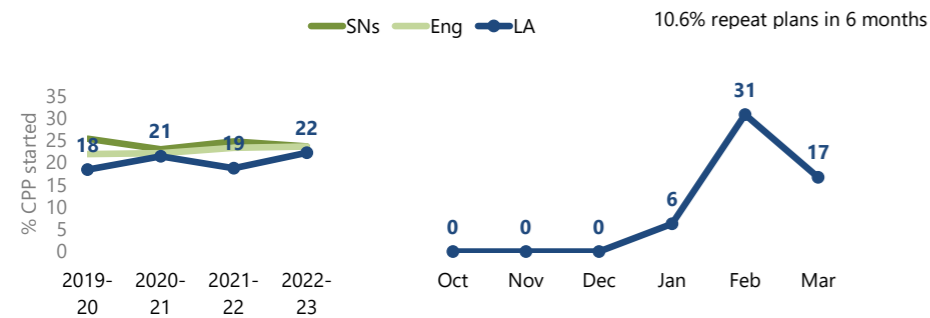
ICPC timeliness (with 15 days)



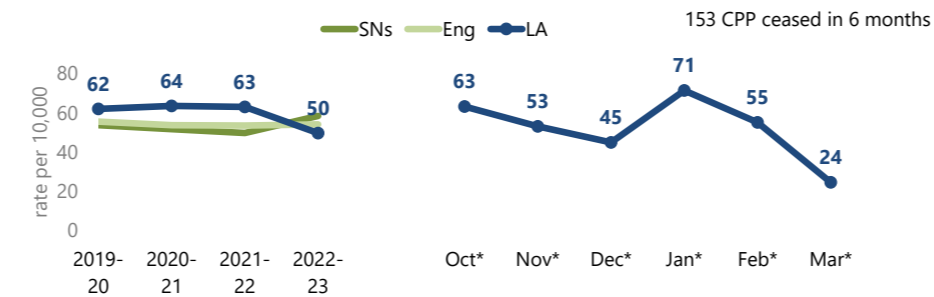
Rate of children who started a CP plan (per 10k)

Rate of children who ceased a CP plan (per 10k)

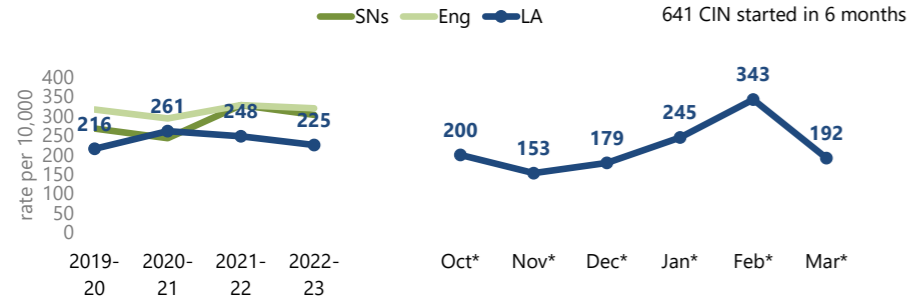

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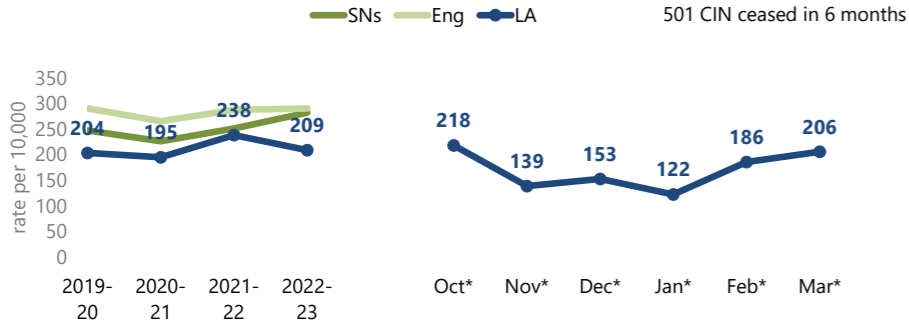
Children in Need (CIN)

Rate of children who started an episode of need per 10,000 children aged 0-17



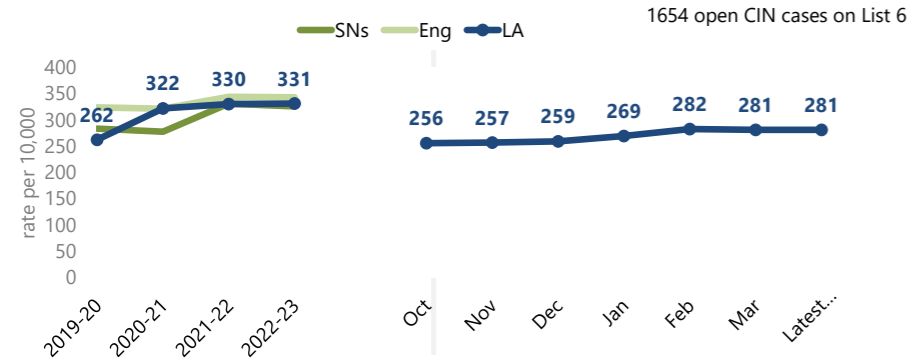

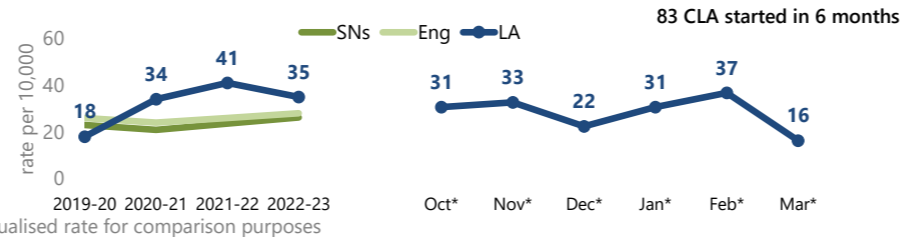
Rate of children with an open episode of need per 10,000 children aged 0-17



Children Looked After (CLA)

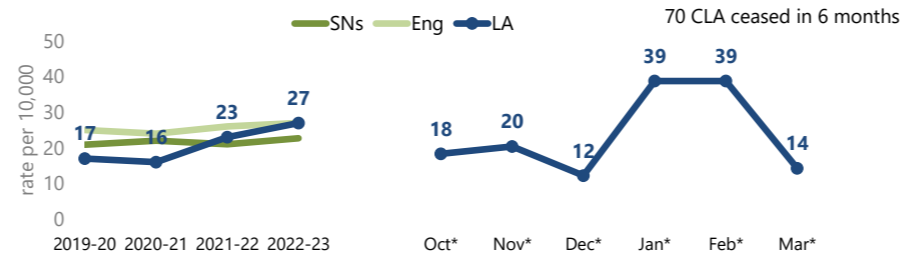

Rate of CLA started per 10,000 children



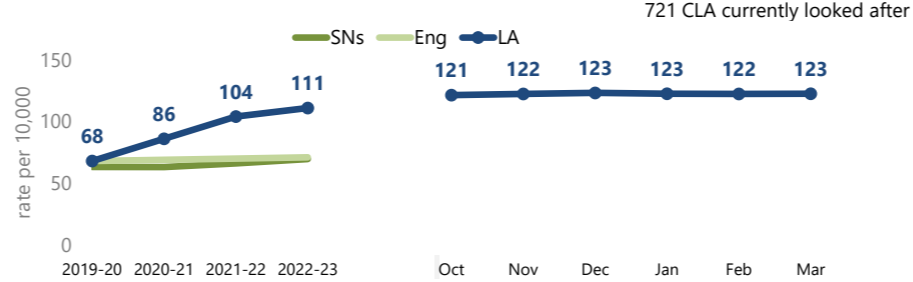
