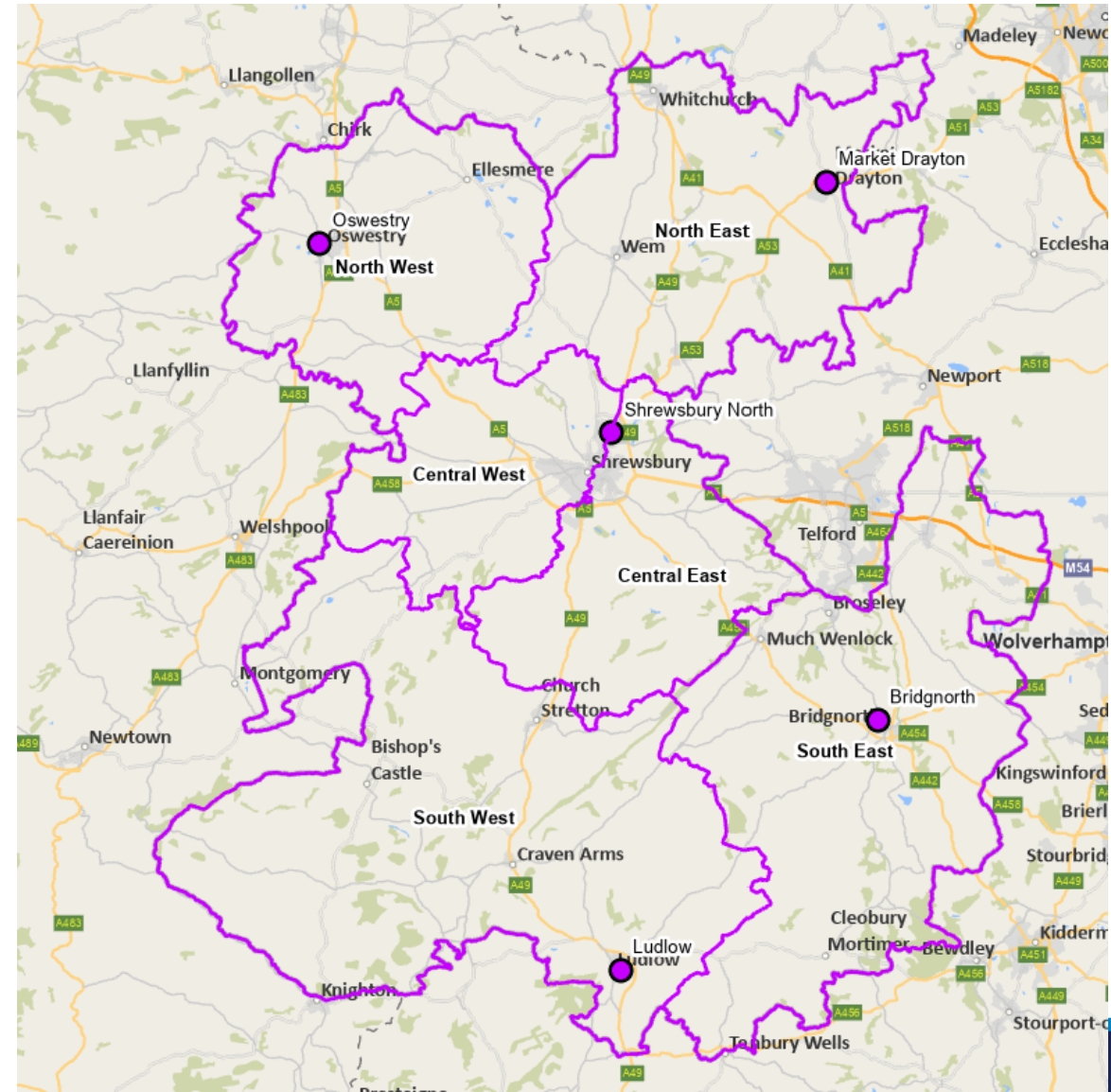
Family hub areas

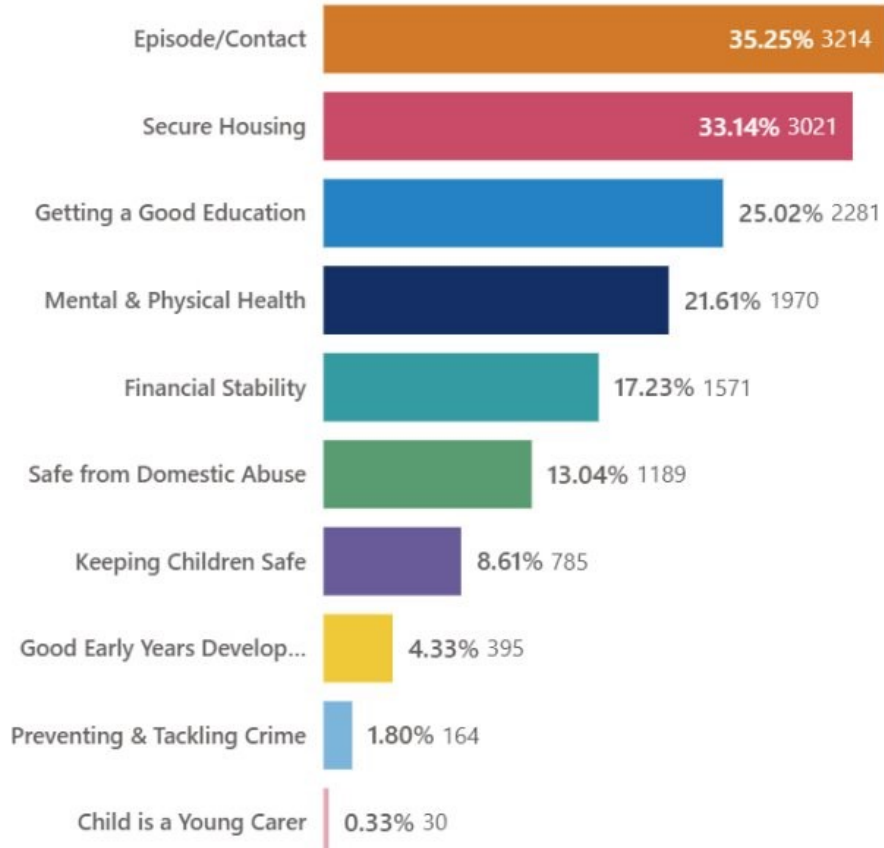

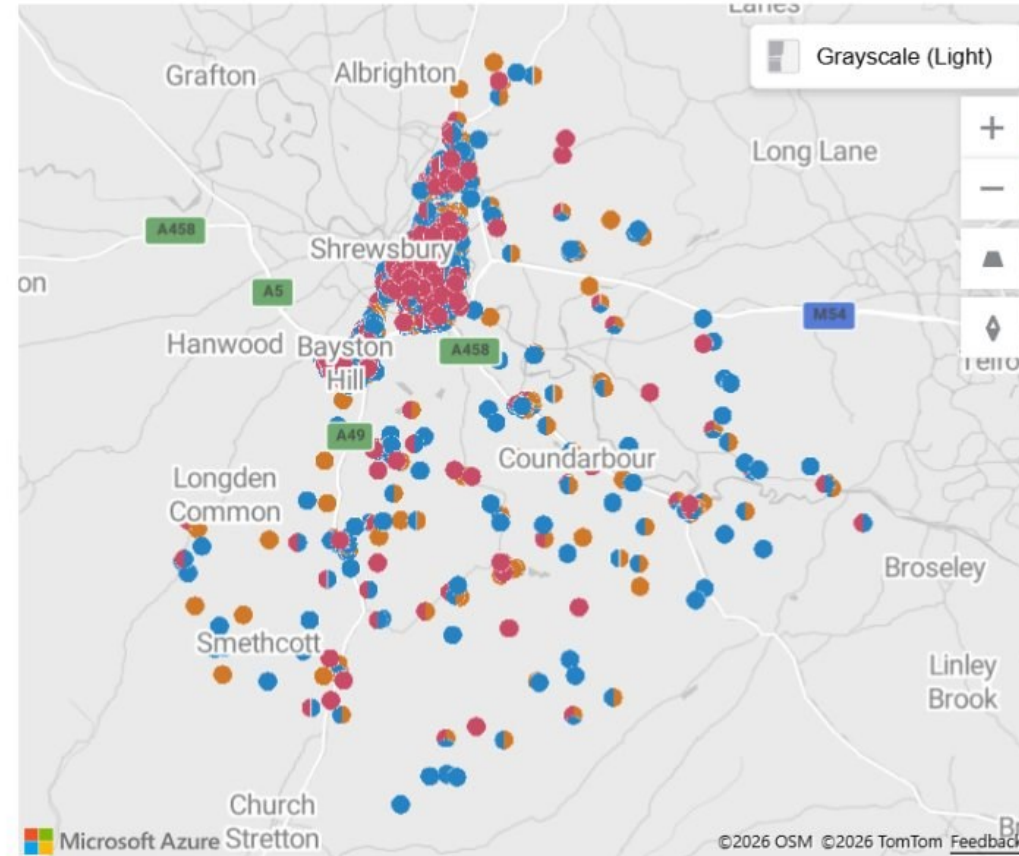


Number of Residents per Category of Need

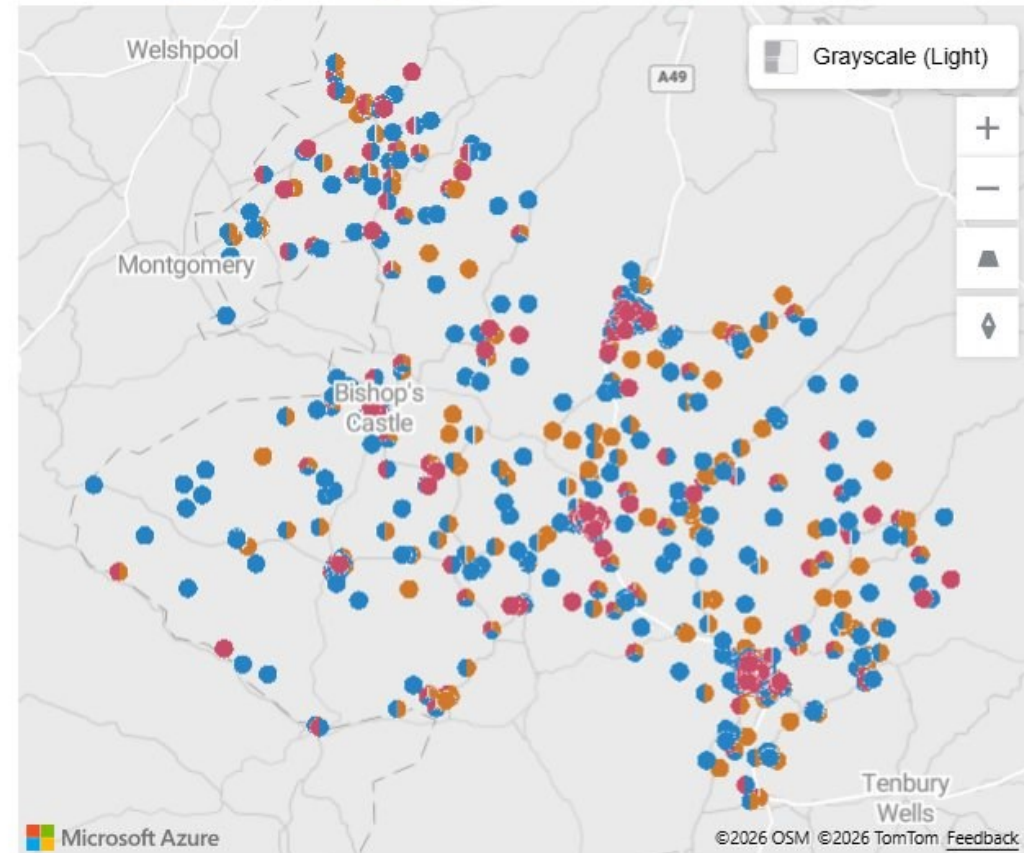


Number of Residents per Category of Need

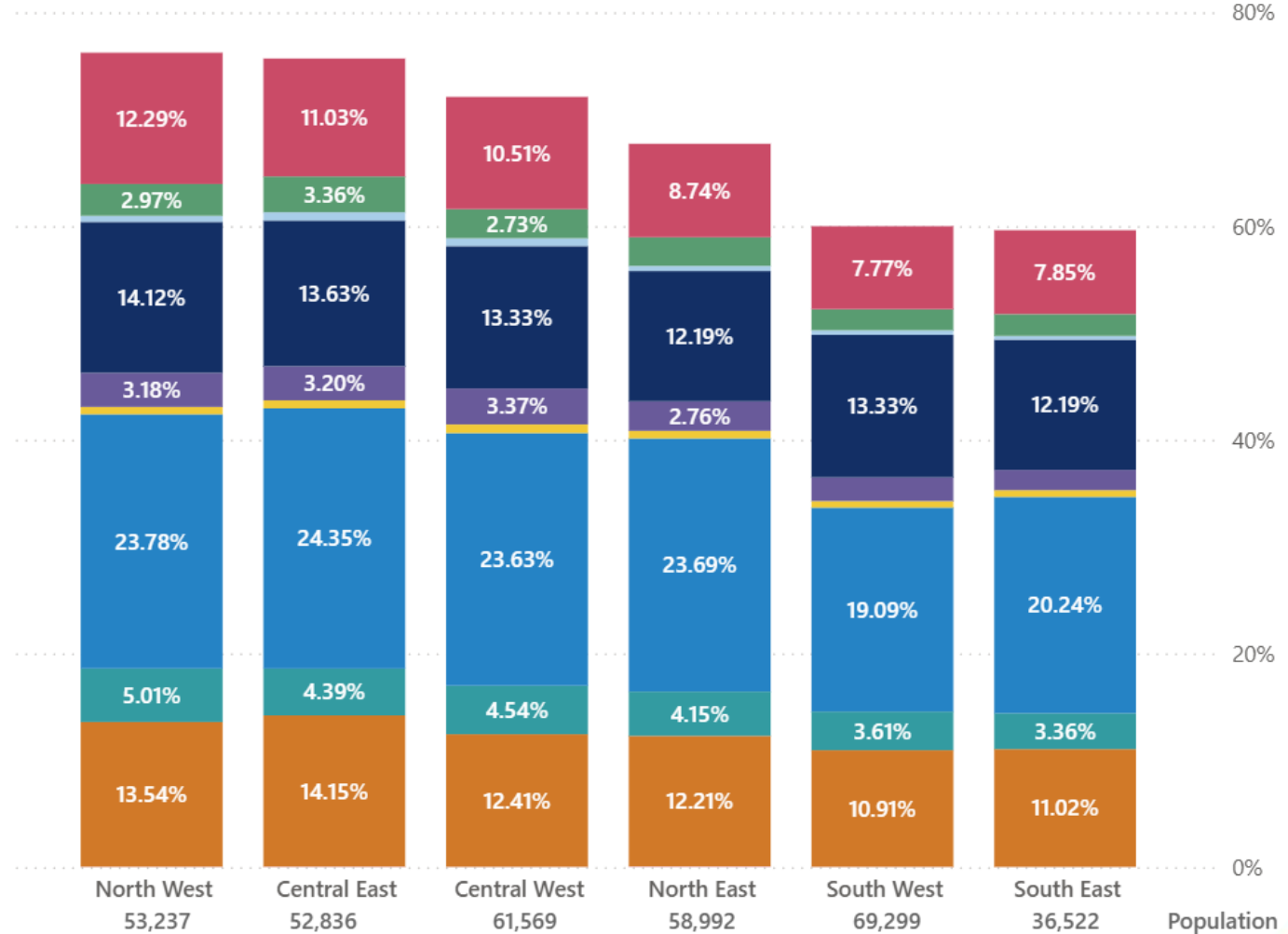

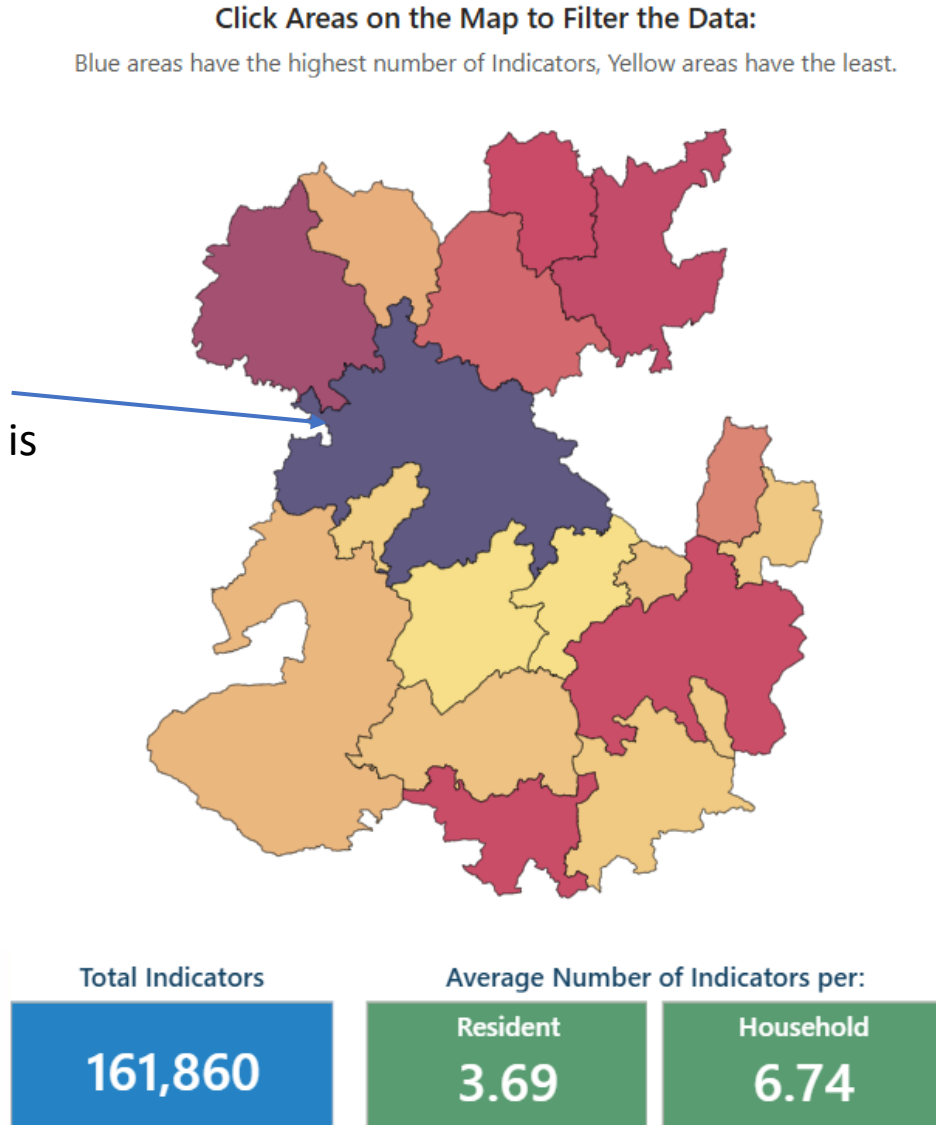

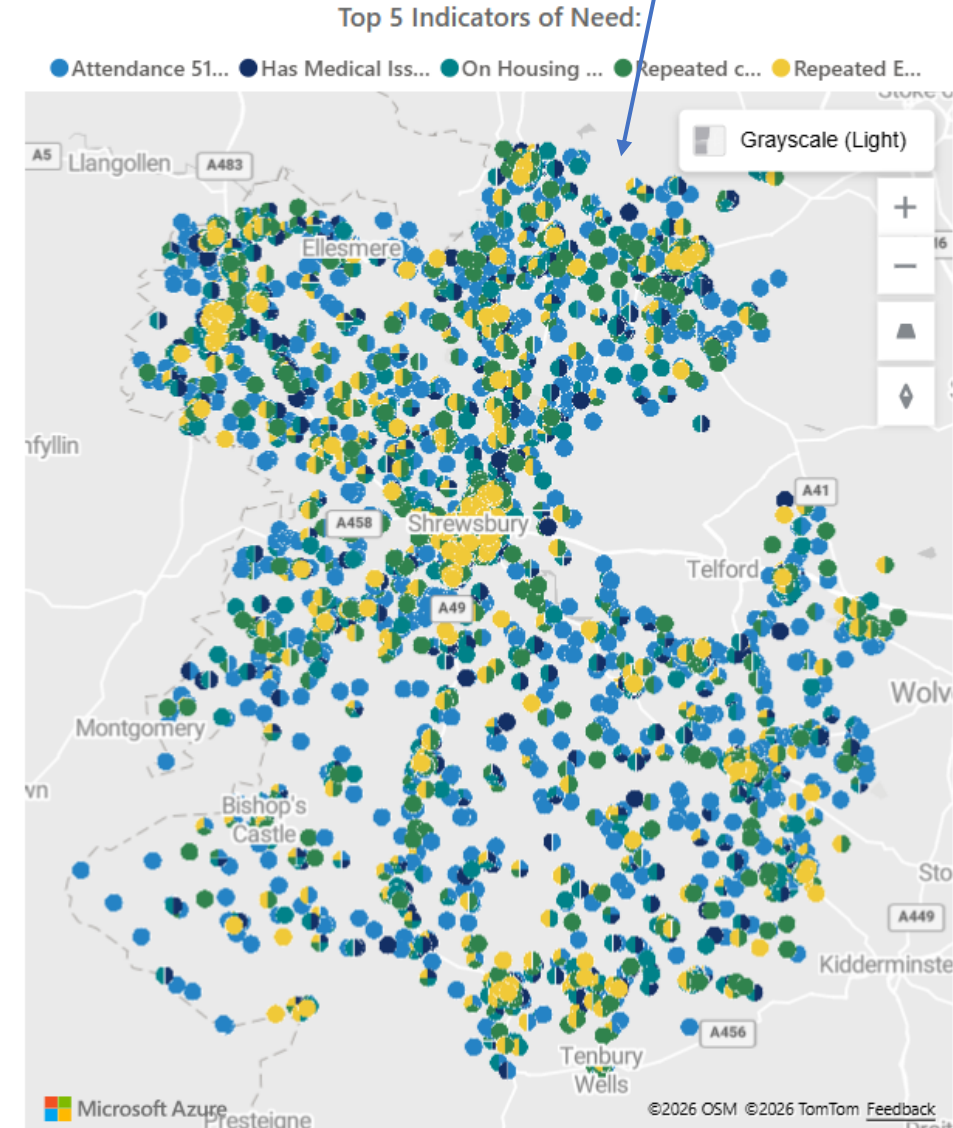

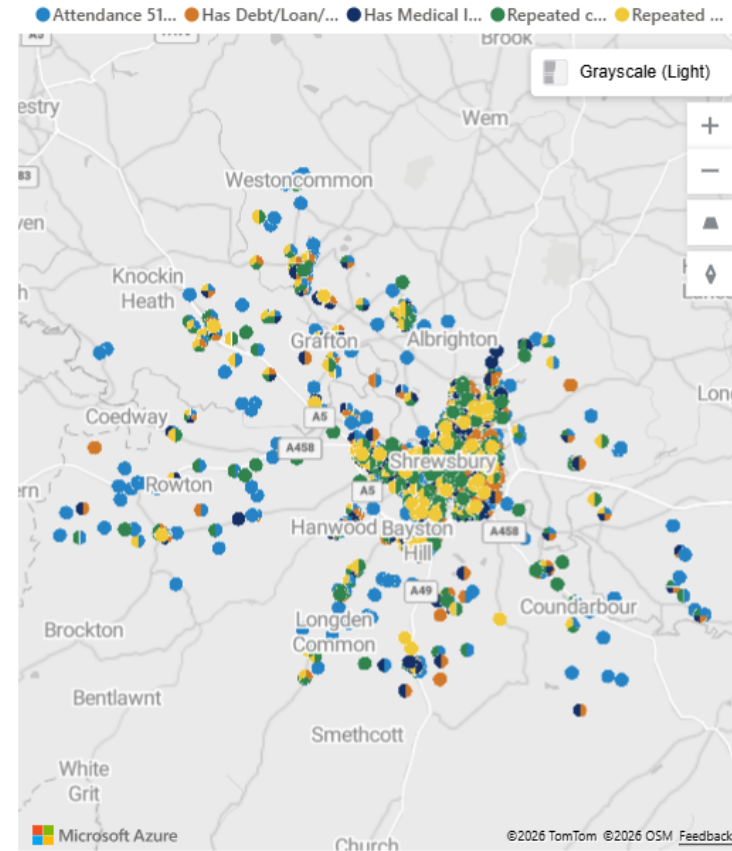

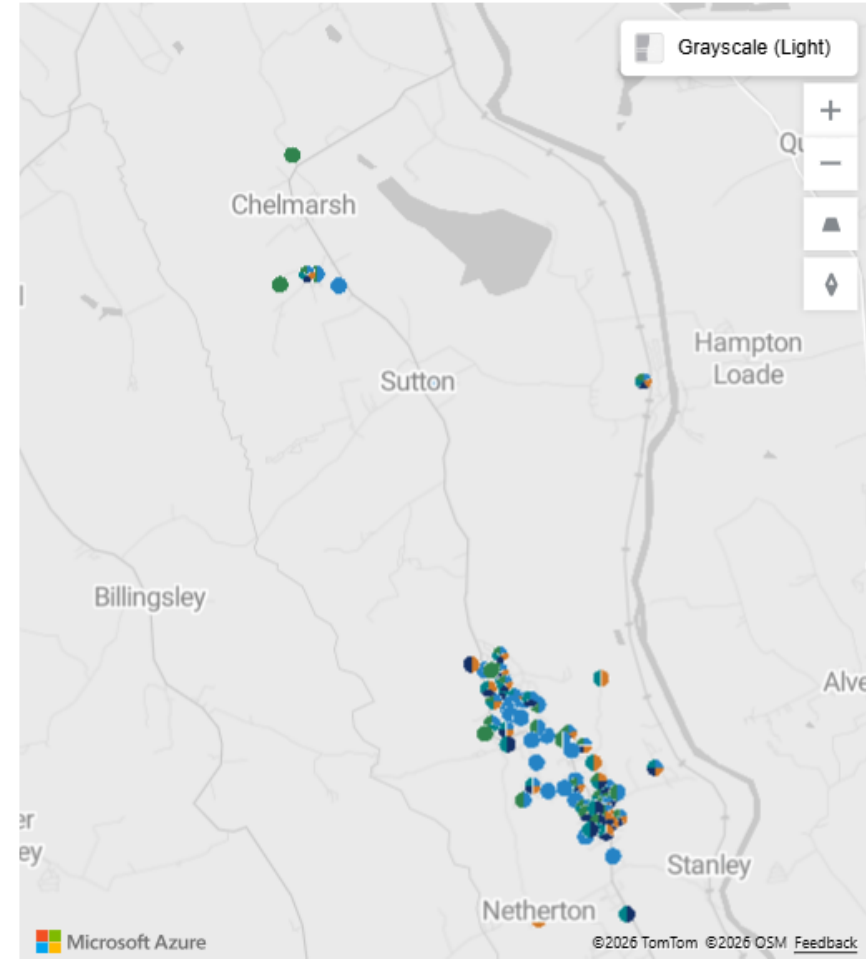

In Summary....

- On Average, areas have similar average spread of indicators per resident and household – this suggests that there are clusters of properties where indicators occur more frequently & we don't have new residents requiring the same intervention.
- Most residents are affected primarily by similar / the same indicators across the county
- Generally, the spread of indicators are proportional to the number of residents & households per area – i.e most areas that have less indicators have less residents than other areas of larger quantity
- Some areas might be a surprise!!!!



Is there a Phase 4?

Honest answer is yes and no!

Nothing further planned at this stage but...

Following the build of the single view of the child project, we can revise this project enabling this to become more dynamic, useful to all services, and timelier for when we come to review hub performance.

How?

The Single view will include wider datasets from more partners to be built into a central data record, so we can match people at record level more accurately, and establish better identification of households and households including children.
