

REGISTER OF MEMBERS' INTERESTS GENERAL NOTICE OF REGISTRABLE INTERESTS

I, lan Edward West, a Member of Broseley Town Council, set out below under the appropriate headings my interests, which I am required to declare under the Localism Act 2011 and the Council's Code of Conduct and I have put "none " where I have no such interests under any heading.

Registering Interests

Within 28 days of becoming a Member or your re-election or re-appointment to office you must register with the Monitoring Officer the interests which fall within the categories set out in **Table 1 (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests)** which are described in 'The <u>Relevant Authorities (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012'</u>. You should also register details of your other personal interests which fall within the categories set out in **Table 2 (Other Registerable Interests)**.

"Disclosable pecuniary interest" means an interest of yourself, or of your partner if you are aware of your partner's interest, within the descriptions set out in Table 1 below.

"Partner" means a spouse or civil partner, or a person with whom you are living as husband or wife, or a person with whom you are living as if you are civil partners.

- You must ensure that your register of interest is kept up-to-date and within 28 days of becoming aware of any new interest, or of any change to a registered interest, notify the Monitoring Officer.
- 2. A 'sensitive interest' is an interest which, if disclosed, could lead to the Councillor, or a person connected with the Councillor, being subject to violence or intimidation.
- Where you have a 'sensitive interest' you must notify the Monitoring Officer with the reasons why you believe it is a sensitive interest. If the Monitoring Officer agrees they will withhold the interest from the public register.

Registrable Non-Pecuniary Interests

Members are only obliged to register their own interests under this heading and do not need to include the interests of their spouse or civil partner

- (b) Any body
 - (i) exercising functions of a public nature;
 - (ii) directed to charitable purposes; or

- (2) provide information that the member knows to be false or misleading; or
- (3) provide information being reckless as to whether it is true and not misleading.

I also acknowledge that it may be a breach of the Members' Code of Conduct to:-

- fail to register or disclose a disclosable pecuniary interest; or (1)
- fail to register with the Monitoring Officer any gift or hospitality with an estimated value of (2)at least £25 within 28 days of its receipt; or
- fail to register with the Monitoring Officer any significant gift or hospitality that I have been (3)offered but have refused to accept.
