

## What is a "body exercising functions of a public nature"?

Although it is not possible to produce a definitive list of such bodies, here are some criteria to consi deciding whether or not a body meets that definition -

- does that body carry out a public service?
- is the body taking the place of local or central government in carrying out the function?
- is the body (including one outsourced in the private sector) exercising a function delegated public authority?
- is the function exercised under legislation or according to some statutory power?
- can the body be judicially reviewed?

Inless you answer "yes" to one of the above questions, it is unlikely that the body in your case is unctions of a public nature. Examples of bodies included in this definition: government agencies, ouncils, public health bodies, council-owned companies exercising public functions, arms-length nanagement organisations carrying out housing functions on behalf of a council, school governing

Remember that if because of membership of a political union any payment or financial benefit is received, it is likely to come under the Sponsors.
