4	<p>Shropshire Choices – a full discussion took place about the development of the site since moving across to Shropshire Council. A number of concerns were discussed and the following points were agreed to be fed back to the web support team and Dale Shepherd:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The importance of downloadable or printable factsheets • The importance of the ‘Directory of local services’ which had previously been updated by the services involved. Recently updated information is missing and needs to be reinstated. There may be a need to look at ways of supporting services to update their information in the future. • The image of the site, which seems to have lost all visual elements and colours, has become quite ‘corporate’ in its look.
