

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 16 (PART), PARISH OF BERRINGTON)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018**

The above named order made on 6th September 2018 by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will **divert**

the full width of that part of Footpath 16, Berrington, from point A on the order map (SJ 5297 0684) where it leaves the County Road, running in a general south westerly direction between the eastern boundary of the site of a new dwelling and a dried up pond then continuing through a small copse to the south western corner of a field at point B (SJ 5291 6676) on the order map at its junction with the remainder of Footpath 16; a total distance of approximately 110 metres; **onto a line** from point C (SJ 5290 0686) on the order map where it leaves the County Road via a pedestrian gate, running in a general southerly followed by south-south-easterly direction following a field edge path on a natural surface to point B (SJ 5291 6676) on the order map at its junction with the remainder of Footpath 16; a total distance of approximately 112 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

A copy of the order and the order map and an explanatory statement have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Council offices at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours or via the Council's website at <https://shropshire.gov.uk/outdoor-partnerships/countryside-access-and-public-rights-of-way/current-public-path-orders/>. Any representations about or objections to the order may be sent in writing to Shropshire Outdoor Partnerships, Rights of Way Mapping and Enforcement Manager, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, SY2 6ND, or by email to outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk, not later than 5th October 2018. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
