

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FP 8 (PART) PARISH OF LLANYMYNECH & PANT)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019**

The above named order made on 27TH June 2019 by the Shropshire Council (“the Council”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will **divert**

That part of FP 8 leaving point A on the Order Map (SJ 2732 2109) running in a general north easterly direction through a fenced area, the footpath then continues in a general ENE then NNW direction on a natural surface to point B on the Order Map (SJ 2746 2119). A total distance of approximately 186 metres **onto a line** leaving point A on the Order Map (SJ 2732 2109) running in a general ENE, NNE then ENE on a 2 metre wide natural surface path with a central strip laid to stone to point B on the Order Map (SJ 2746 2119). A total distance of approximately 187 metres.

A copy of the order and the order map and an explanatory statement have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Council offices at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours or via the Council’s website at <https://shropshire.gov.uk/outdoor-partnerships/countryside-access-and-public-rights-of-way/current-public-path-orders/>. Copies of the order and map may be bought from the Council, at the above address at a cost of £6.50.

Any representations about or objections to the order may be sent in writing to Shropshire Outdoor Partnerships, Rights of Way Mapping and Enforcement Manager, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, SY2 6ND, or by email to outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk, not later than 25th July 2019. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
