

COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY (CIL) Form 6: Commencement Notice

CIL Form 6: Commencement Notice must be completed and received by the Council prior to the commencement of development (i.e. at least one day before) otherwise a surcharge will be applicable. The Council can only accept notification of commencement on CIL Form 6: Commencement Notice.

For the purposes of CIL, development commences when a material operation in accordance with Section 56(4) of the Town and Country Planning Act (1990) takes place. This Act defines a material operation as:

- (a) Any work of construction in the course of the erection of a building;
- (aa) Any work of demolition of a building;
- (b) The digging of a trench which is to contain the foundations, or part of the foundations, of a building;
- (c) The laying of any underground main or pipe to the foundations, or part of the foundations, of a building or to any such trench as is mentioned in paragraph (b);
- (d) Any operation in the course of laying out or constructing a road or part of a road;
- (e) Any change in the use of any land which constitutes material development.

Please Note: *it is the responsibility of the liable party to understand and comply with the National CIL Regulations, including any eligibility for relief. Applications for relief must be submitted and determined prior to commencement of development. Further details can be found at: www.shropshire.gov.uk/CIL*

I also acknowledge that failure to notify the CIL Collecting Authority of the intended date of commencement by submitting a commencement notice in advance of this date will result in the CIL Collecting Authority imposing a surcharge of 20% of the amount of CIL due for payment, up to a maximum of £2,500 and will result in the CIL amount being due for payment in full on the date of commencement. I confirm that a copy of this notice has been served on all persons known to me as an owner of the land on which the chargeable development will be built. For the purpose of CIL, an owner is an owner of a freehold interest in the relevant land or a leasehold interest in the relevant land of 7 years or more from the date planning permission first permits the chargeable development.
