#### Collecting and storing your personal data

## 1. Why we need this data to be collected

To keep everyone safe organisations have been asked to keep a <u>temporary record</u> of visitors and staff for 21 days. In the event of a local outbreak of the virus this data may be used to assist NHS Test and Trace as needed. This could help contain clusters or outbreaks in your community.

## 2. Do I have to provide the information?

This is a <u>voluntary scheme</u> and nobody visiting these premises is required to provide their details.

Although this is a voluntary scheme we strongly encourage staff, customers and visitors to share their details in order to support NHS Test and Trace.

### 3. How will the information be shared?

NHS Test and Trace will ask for these records <u>only where it is necessary</u>, either because someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 has named these premises as a place they visited recently, or because these premises have been identified as the location of a potential local outbreak of COVID-19.

NHS Test and Trace will work with you, if contacted, to ensure that information is shared in a safe and secure way.

# 4. Legal Basis for Processing

The information that you provide will be processed in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation and Data Protection Act 2018: GDPR Article 6(1)(f): legitimate interests as specified in the Government guidance.

#### 5. Data Retention Period

Information which is collected and stored solely for NHS Test and Trace will <u>be</u> retained for 21 days.

This reflects the incubation period for COVID-19 (which can be up to 14 days) and an additional 7 days to allow time for testing and tracing. After 21 days, this information will be securely disposed of or deleted.
