## THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (BRIDLEWAY UN1 (PART), PARISH OF CHESWARDINE) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020

The above named order made on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2020, by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will **divert** part of BW UN1 from Point A (SJ 7448 3180) on the order map running in an easterly direction along the access to Lipley Heath Farm continuing to run through the yard, through some gates to point B (SJ 7458 3181) on the order map. A total distance of approximately 98 metres. **Onto a line** Point C on the order map (SJ 7448 3182) from the County Road at a bridleway gate and passing into a pasture field and running in an easterly direction, south easterly then easterly direction across the field to point B (SJ 7458 3181) on the order map at a bridleway gate. A total distance of approximately 105 metres, with a width of 3 metres throughout.
