


Grazing land available: Cosford (former Ruckley Refuse Tip) Bonemill Lane, Shifnal, Shropshire TF11 9HH

The opportunity has arisen to enter into a Licence agreement for the grazing and/or mowing of 14.14 hectares (approx. 34.96 acres) of land on Bonemill Lane nr Shifnal. Access is from the A464 south of Shifnal, turning into Bonemill Lane, and there is a narrow track accessing the land from the lane. The site runs adjacent to the main Shrewsbury to Birmingham train line.



Applications of interest are sought, to include contact details, planned use of the site, and a bid to include a proposed annual licence fee for the rights available. The licence fee to be paid annually in advance for a licence period which is anticipated to run until 30th November 2021. Please submit bids by 4th December 2020 via email if possible.

The successful applicant will be responsible for and required to maintain the fences, gates, ditches and hedges at the site, and provide access for Shropshire Council or their contractors for the purposes of carrying out surveys or other reasons as required. There is no water to the site, and the existence/security of fencing or hedges has not been inspected.
