Staff Guidance for Covid-19 Test & Isolation of School Transport Pupils/Drivers/PAs: 'Quick Reference Table' at April 2021

Type of Case	Action
Does not have symptoms of COVID-19 and Lateral Flow Device (LFD) Test Positive	Isolate with household members and get PCR test ASAP. Report positive LFD result to school immediately for further risk assessment of need for pupils using school transport to isolate (until results of PCR are known).
Does not have symptoms of COVID-19 symptoms and PCR test negative	No isolation required unless someone else in your household has symptoms or you have been advised by Test & Trace to isolate.
Does not have symptoms of COVID-19 and PCR tests positive	<p>Isolate with household for 10 full days* from date of test. If you develop symptoms during 10 days of isolation, then only the positive case restarts 10 days of isolation. Household members who develop symptoms of COVID-19 should have a PCR test and if positive should isolate for 10 full days* from onset of their own symptoms. Other household members do not need to restart their isolation period.</p> <p>Report positive PCR result to school immediately for further risk assessment of need for pupils using school transport to isolate</p>

<p>Has symptoms of COVID-19</p>	<p>Get PCR test and isolate with household ASAP until results of PCR test is known. There is no need to notify the school unless you receive a positive result.</p>
<p>Has symptoms of COVID-19 and PCR Test Positive</p>	<p>Isolate with household for 10 full days* from onset of your symptoms. Household members who develop symptoms should have a PCR test and if positive should isolate for 10 full days* from onset of their own symptoms. Other household members do not need to restart isolation.</p> <p>Report positive PCR result to school immediately for further risk assessment of need for pupils using school transport to isolate</p>
<p>Has symptoms of COVID-19 and PCR Test Negative</p>	<p>You do not usually need to isolate if you test negative or are well, and no-one else in your household has symptoms and you have not been advised by Test & Trace to self-isolate, but keep following all social distancing advice.</p>
<p>Identified as a 'Contact' by Test & Trace or Public Health</p> <p>NB You can be a contact anytime from 2 days before the person who tested positive developed their symptoms, and up to 10 days after, as this is when they can pass the infection on to others.</p> <p>A 'Contact' is someone:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● in the same household, ● or with face-to-face contact within one metre, ● or over one minute without face-to-face contact ● or within 2 metres of someone for more than 15 minutes, <p>in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.</p> <p>A person may also be a 'Contact' if they have travelled in the same vehicle or plane as a positive case.</p>	<p>Isolate for 10 full days from date provided by Test & Trace/Public Health.</p> <p>For household contacts this will be from the same date as the confirmed case & for other contacts it will be for 10 full days since their last contact with the positive case.</p>
<p>Contact of a 'Contact'</p>	<p>Isolation not required for this reason.</p>
