Clive is still being considered as a Community Hub in spite of irrefutable facts, namely the inclusion of **two amenities / services** which are not present in the village. The former **Bowling green** has been located within a private garden for *circa* two years now and has been unavailable for villagers use; owner has said land will be used for other purposes and has no intentions to reopen for former use. The **village shop** which operated on only a part-time basis closed October 2020, the owner has already confirmed to the Council that he will not be reopening or re-letting the premises (which are next to his dwelling-house) for any sort of business use. The continued inclusion of these two amenities gives Clive enough points to remain as a Community Hub, clearly inaccurate and outdated. Since October 2020 and for the foreseeable long-term future the removal of these two results in a score of 47 points, **insufficient for Clive to be a Community Hub.** Incidentally, for future consideration, having 2 or sometimes 4 hours weekly in Village Hall does NOT in my opinion warrant awarding significant points for a Post Office service, sometimes unable to perform as required due to technical communication problems.

Removal of the **Bowling green** and **village shop** from the list of amenities /services allegedly continuing to serve Clive despite unavailability for two years and over three months respectively. The corrected score of 47 points accurately reflects the current ongoing situation within Clive, now nothing more than a dormitory village with very few amenities other than a Medical Centre with dispensary (NOT a pharmacy) plus a primary school; so-called Post Office service is inadequate. Clive cannot therefore continue to be classified as a Community Hub under the present points system.
