SCC have ignored evidence provided by the Parish Council clearly demonstrating
A) The shop has closed and will not re-open evidenced by reason of a change of use to domestic dwelling that has been submitted to SCC in January 2021. Despite the fact that SCC have been advised a number of times that the closing of this facility is permanent, SCC still allocate the number of points for this facility.
B) The property on which the bowing green was sited changed hands in 2017 and the new owner gave written notice to the small number of users that this facility was no longer available. Again SCC were advised of this but continue to allocate points despite this facility not being in existance for some years.

When the points allocated for these two facilities are removed, the points system brings Clive below Hub status.
