[^0]There were 2 parish councllors on the working group that developed this plan and lam concerned that the Parish Counclf are already taking as read that this Communty Hub ls a given - thay shouid not be taking this opinlon.
Moving onto the way In which Cross Houses has been selected for Community Hub status I would make the following points The proposed Hub status is based on a points system and there are several areas of contention in the scoring of services facilitles and empioyment for Cross Houses.

1. Cross Houses had polnts awarded for having a Library - in the context of the scoring system, called the Hlerarchy of Settiements Assessment Document, Ibrary refers to a static permanant fixture as are all other facilties mentioned.
A mobile llbrary which visits twice a month for $\mathbf{2 5}$ minutes each time does not constitute having a library which peopie could, If required, visit datly for lelsure or research purposes. A static library is not mentioned In the Hierarchy of Settlements Assessment Document and appears to have been added speciflcally to qualfy.
2. Children's Playground - single provision oniy not multiple as stated
3. Amenity Green Space - single provision only not multiple as stated
4. Outdoor sports facilty - which I presume is a playing feld - which ls not owned by the Parish and which is fust really a field and which has over the fast 3 months November 2020 - January 2024 been regularly flooded.

I would request that the Inspector at the forthcoming Publlc Inquiry comes and Inspects these facilties to determine if this points scoring assessment by Shropshlre Council is appropriate.
Should it be found that a deduction of points is required to be made I belleve that Cross Houses would then remain as Open Countryside status which I assume will last for at least 20 years and will mean that no further farge scate housing developments will occur within or around the village.
