Moving onto the way In which Cross Houses has been selected for Cemmunity Hub status I would make the following points The proposed Hub status is based on a polnts system and there are several areas of contention In the scoring of services, facilities and employment for Cross Houses.

1. Cross Houses had points awarded for having a Library - In the context of the scoring system, callad the Hierarchyof Settiements Assessment Document, library refers to a static permanent fixture as are all other facilities mentloned.
A moble library which vistts twice a month for 25 minutes each time does not constitute having a lifrary which: people could, if requlred, vislt datly for lelsure or research purposes. A static library is not mentioned in the Herarchy of Settlements Assessment Document and appears to have been added specfically to qualify.
2. Children's Playground - single provision only not multiple as stated
3. Amenty Green Space - single provision only not multiple as stated
4. Outdoor sports facility - which I presume is a playlng fleld - whtch is not owned by the Parish and which is fust really a field and which has over the last 3 months November 2020 - January 2021 been regularly flooded.

I would request that the Inspector at the forthcoming Public Inquiry comes and inspects these facilthes to determine if this points scoring assessment by Shropshire Council is approprlate.
Should it be found that a deduction of points is required to be made I belfeve that Cross Kouses would then remain as Open Countryside status which 1 assume will last for at least 20 years and will mean that no further large scale housing developments will occur wifhin or around the village.

Whilst the Local Plan currently does not allocate any significant new housing settlements to Cross Houses it none the less still defines it as a Communlty Hub, thus allowing the possibility of future development In the next few years when a 'refresh' to the Locai Plan takes place.
    I want Cross Houses to remain as Open Countryside and not be designated a Communlty Hub so ensuring that ṇo slgnificant housing development will be allowed to take place for the life span of this Local Plan.
    The residents of Cross Houses have had to put up with large housebuilding sites for several years with all the problems this entalis such as Increased traffic, particularly constructlon traffic noise and housing belng bulit on proviously arable countryslde. I belleve that the majortty of residentsin Cross Houses do not want any more large scale development of thair village.
    A full scale needs survey needs to be undertaken of our village so that the community can understand just exactly what it is that that the village wantş. Untll this Ís done lam not sure how Shropshire Council Planning Department can uinderstand what is right for our village. Recently the Parlsh Council sent out a Community Led Plan questlonnalre. Nowhere on this consultation document did It state that Cross Houses is stllitassifled as, Open Countryside andit did not ask a fundamental question of the reciplents as to whether they would prefer to remain Open Countryside and herice have the opton of not having to accept any further large scale developments. Not only this nelther did thils questionnalre ask a more baslc quastion of whather or not residents wanted any more housing in their viliage.
    I would ask that the inspector at the Public inquiry specifically looks into this issue and asks the Parlsh Councll why they chose not inform the communlty of this fact and why specffic guestions regarding housing were omitted from this survey.
