Soundness

The Draft Shropshire Plan is not sound as the lower part of the prefered site is subject to frequent flooding which on occasions (6 times in the last 12 months) has flooded gardens outbuildings of adjecent properties. In Febuary 2020 the floodwater entered 2 homes at the bottom of Hunters Gate causing extensive damage. The flooding has become worse and

more frequent in recent years . The development of the nearby Callaughton Ash site and the rate of climate change may each have had an influence on the extent and frequency of flooding. Until the flooding problem has been resolved no new housing should be permitted on the site or on nearby sites.

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What should be done

The development of the preferred site should be rejected.

A study should be undertaken of the flood risks across the whole town and catchment area.

Optimum strategies and locations for development in the short ,medium and long term should then be agreed in consultation with the community through a review of the Neighourhood Plan.
