The definition of Hub status included the requirement to have both significant employment and peak time public transport Treforen has reither of these, - very few employment opportunities and prictically no peak time transport. Any Treforen resident needs a car, with implications of engine emissions and difficulty of access with narrow roads and lanes. If the requirements of employment & transport have been relaxed, this seems to work against the proposed SP3 Chinate Change + Sustainability Objectives, Seeking to minimise car travel 2 to reduce carbon emissions. 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It is important that the Hierarchy of Settlements ties in with the SP3 Climate Change and Susbainability Objectives which seek to minimise car travel and to maximise trips by Sustainable travel. This is not the case, so the Hierarchy of Settlements should be amended Treforen cannot be claimed to have significant employment opportunities or regular peak time transport.
