The draft Local Plan takes no account of the Act of Parliament and policies in respect of 'localism'. Nor does it comply with clearly expressed local sentiment and recommendations in the Much Wenlock Neighbourhood Plan. Flooding is a major issue in Much Wenlock yet the local authority has failed in its legal duties in this respect, despite extensive representaions from local residents affected.

The suggestion that employment can be generated in Much Wenlock is unsound, as evidenced by the failure, over many years, of take-up of land made available.


