I think Cressage should remain Open Countryside and should not be considered a Community Hub. The residents have voiced their concerns about this many times and have been ignored by the Parish Council. This consultation process has been riddled with problems from the beginning and has been exacerbated by Covid 19. No public consultation events have been held. This would have helped Cressage residents to form an opinion and gather all the facts.

Also, I am very concerned that the Council have ignored the environmental impact of creating large scale housing developments in Cressage. The sites that have allocated for development cause grave concerns about the environmental impact. The site CES005 is a habitat for slow worms, newts, frogs, bats and other species. Since the residents have never seen a proposed plan for this site, residents are left not knowing if and how the wildlife will be protected. There has been no communication as to how the site would be developed.

If Cressage becomes a Community Hub, we will be exposed to large housing developments that will not take into consideration the environment.

I ask that the Independent inspector reviews the Countryside Charitys objections and responses and considers them in depth.

I ask the Independent inspector to review Shropshire Councils consultation process during Covid19 and the obvious impacts that has had on preventing people from replying.
