b) medical; local general practice unable to cope with the increased capacity.

d) Employment; where are these home-owners goin to work? Large movement of vehicles towards other centres of employment; this goes against a greener ideas of the national government; more cars on the road and more miles travelled; not sound.

e) Tourism; Bridgnorth is attractive as a tourist centre but this development will spoil the nature and quality of the town; it will swamp the very attractiveness of the town.

f) Utilities; drainage; the land slopes down to the Mor Brook; is this the way that the surface drainage will go and flood the Mor brook and its tributaries. Sewerage how will the current facilities cope with the extra demands?
