Ruyton is designated as a Community Hub settlement where only one site has been included for housing allocation in the Local Plan Review. As a Community Hub, the Council should have a duty to provide more than one allocated site as there is more potential for deliverability if more than one site is allocated. Allocation site RUY019 was included as having long term investment potential, and as yet there is still no progress in developing the site. The site is currently used by a haulage contractors and does not have scope for immediate deliverability. In the previous consultation periods we have suggested the inclusion of our client's land in Ruyton as it provides scope for housing immediately and would act as sustainable infilling. It appears the Council did not give sufficient consideration to the benefits of this site to deliver housing. Q5. 


