The Council has not met its commitment to meaningful public engagement. The work of								

Neighbourhood Plan Refresh has been ignored by both Shropshire Council and the Town Council. This is inexplicable. Much Wenlock is fortunate to have both committed life-long residents and newer arrivals – retirees with time and energy to care. No-one wants to stop all development but they want a step by step approach to meet local needs – eg affordable housing, housing for the elderly. They want elected representatives who listen, consult and liaise openly with all concerned; the public, land-owners, Severn Trent, traffic managers. Plans to manage the flood risk and a huge increase of traffic from neighbouring developments
