What would I be doing?	<p>You would:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • help to organise and/or deliver children's activities such as story time, Rhyme Time and craft activities; • talk to children and their parents about children's activities; • gather feedback and promote library events.
Am I right for this opportunity?	<p>Ideally you will have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • some experience of engaging with children and young people; • a confident, outgoing personality; • good communication skills; • an interest in books, libraries and reading; • creativity and enthusiasm.
What will I get from volunteering?	<p>You will gain:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • valuable training and experience that can be included in CVs and job applications; • the opportunity to meet others in the local community.
When can I do my volunteering?	<p>There are a variety of opportunities throughout the year. Enquire at your local branch for details.</p>
Where will I be volunteering?	<p>You would normally be able to volunteer in a library or virtually using digital devices.</p>
Who will be there with me?	<p>Library staff and other activity and event volunteers.</p>
Support and review	<p>Regular support and guidance will be given by a named library contact.</p> <p>There will be an agreed trial period to ensure that all is going well – another volunteer role may be suggested if the trial period has shown that this would be better for both parties.</p>
Training, resources and information	<p>A full induction will be given, and further training offered where appropriate.</p>
