
Recognising needs of children in your setting.



Actions by the setting

Severe delay in one or more areas of development including sensory processing

Severe social and emotional difficulty

Moderate level of need where the child is not making expected progress in more than one of the prime areas

Behaviour impacting on child accessing learning

Long term physical or sensory need

Not making expected progress in one of the prime areas

Behaviour causing concern

Some social anxieties

Children with a recent upset or change in home circumstances

Medical condition

Support parents to get referral to Paediatrician through PHN or GP

Deliver interventions and use strategies to work on targets and outcomes set by other agencies or the EHCP
