We have 'loaned' two teachers from the Physis Group to help us achieve this - David Lyons and Natasha Moore will be supporting us for a few hours each week and may well be in touch with yourselves and social workers, so we wanted you to be aware of who they are for safeguarding purposes.

Where PEPs for the children were 'Needing Development' last term David or Natasha will be in touch to advise around ensuring this term's PEP includes those key things our children need and will be able to answer queries so we can all work jointly on achieving this together.

In the meantime, the VS team is working behind the scenes with our LA Social Care Partners to review how we work together jointly to achieve this aim — and to develop the PEP on the epep platform in response to what you told us at the Autumn DT Network.


