### MATTER 6 - Green Belt and Safeguarded Land (Policy SP11)

### Opening

#### Matter 6 discussion points

- 1. Whether the basis of the Green Belt Review is soundly based, including the methodology and assessment.
- 2. Whether the Green Belt review and decisions on Green Belt releases accord with the advice in paragraphs 141 and 142 of the Framework.
- 3. Whether opportunities to maximise capacity on non-Green Belt sites has been taken (including increasing densities).
- 4. Whether discussions have taken place with neighbouring authorities about whether they could accommodate some of Shropshire's identified housing and employment land needs.

- 5. Whether meeting some of the housing and employment needs of the Black Country has led to the need to release or safeguard more Green Belt land.
- 6. Whether the extent of safeguarded land is sufficient to meet longer term needs beyond the plan period and whether it is justified.
- 7. Whether exceptional circumstances, as required by paragraph 140 of the Framework, exist to justify the Local Plan's proposed removal of land from the Green Belt, including safeguarded land.
- 8. Whether the plan policies adequately set out ways in which the impact of removing land from the Green Belt can be offset through compensatory improvements to the environmental quality and accessibility of remaining Green Belt land.
- 9. Whether the boundaries of all the sites proposed for release or safeguarding are clearly shown on a map. Whether in defining the boundaries regard has been had to paragraph 143 of the Framework.
