I have followed the Neighbourhood Plan meetings and have the following observation for consideration please.

Whilst the Cricket field is considered 'valuable green space' it is not accessible for all, it is not a public right of way and you have to be a member therefore whilst it is a lovely green space its valuable lies within the club itself which is not a Town asset. However, the firey fields are also a valued green space, have been invaluable during the pandemic, are used by hundreds daily for exercise and play yet the wording used for this area is far less expressive of the previous Town Plan. I think the plan, as it stands, does not fully recognise the value of the Firey fields and leaves it open for future development.

I would also question why a previous Mayor, who had little to do with the Neighbourhood Plan, is pictured and and promoted on the document.
