

## Visiting Shirehall

Please note that Shirehall is currently closed to the public and the majority of staff are working from home.

For the purposes of attending for your meeting **please knock on the door at Main Reception on arrival** and follow guidance given by reception staff.

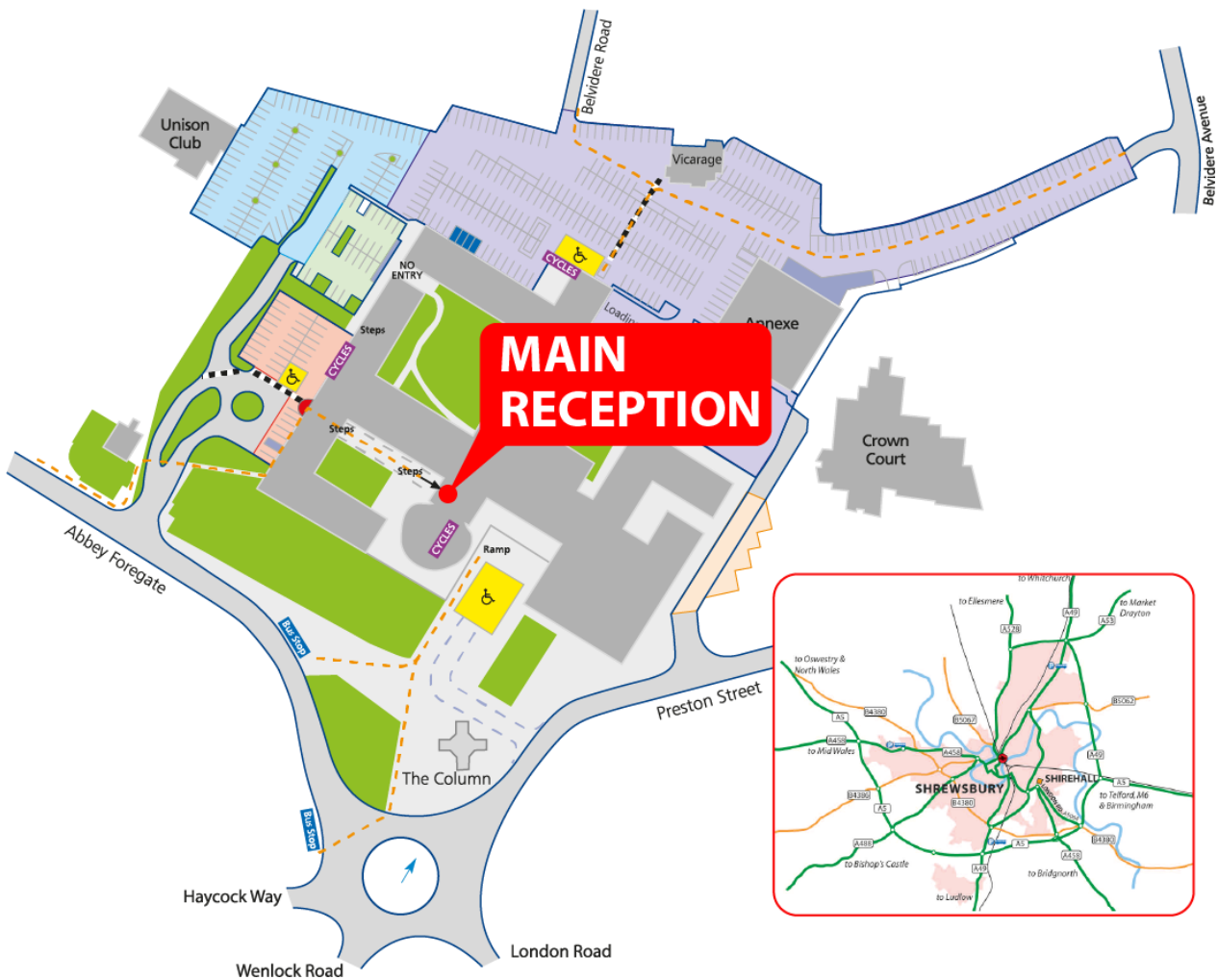
If travelling by car you will need to provide your car registration details on arrival.

## Travelling to Shirehall

### By bus –

A bus runs from the bus station to Shirehall every 15 minutes. The bus stop is right outside Shirehall. All buses run in both directions. Their numbers and destinations are:

- 8 Sutton Road, Shrewsbury
- 81 Wellington
- X5 Telford
- 436 Bridgnorth
- 96 Ironbridge

### By Motorcycle –

You can park your motorcycle to the left of the attendant's office (see map).



**By Car –** Car parking at Shirehall is available. MiPermit car parking system is in operation and all spaces are patrolled by Shropshire Council staff to ensure that people park where permitted.

**Walk or Cycle –** Cycle parking is shown on the map overleaf. Please see [www.cycleshrewsbury.co.uk](http://www.cycleshrewsbury.co.uk) or call 01743 253 008 for a map of Shrewsbury which shows the best walking and cycling routes.

**By Train –** You can get regular, direct trains to Shrewsbury from London, Birmingham, Cardiff, Swansea, Aberystwyth, Holyhead, Chester, Crewe and Manchester. Please see [www.thetrainline.com](http://www.thetrainline.com) for train times, or call 08457 48 49 50 (or, for Welsh, 0845 60 40 500). Textphone 0845 60 50 600. From Shrewsbury train station, you can walk (20 minutes) or cycle (15 minutes) to Shirehall.

**To get from the train to the bus station (a 3 minute, walk)**

Walk to the very top corner of the train station car park.

The traffic lights should be on your right. Cross the road and walk down the pavement (on the left) in front of you. Walk down this road (Smithfield Road) for 2 minutes. The Bus Station will be on your left-hand side

**By Taxi –** There is a taxi rank at the train station
