		Cambrian Railway Building Repairs are ongoing to the corbles and more deterioration than expected was found during inspection, it is anticipated that these repairs will conclude without significant delay. Primary focus is to develop the conservation management plan which will inform next steps. Project manager appointed for options appraisal. Funding will be needed to get the building into operation. Cambrian Heritage Railway Trust have taken on the tenancy of the building and are providing an important caretaking/security role. Discussion with Members about opportunity to undertake other works while the scaffolding is in place, which will be looked into. OTC offered to be involved in stakeholder engagement. Castle View Plan is to consolidate SC use into one part of the building. Remainder will shortly be marketed through an agent. Receiving positive feedback about the building's unique offer within

Alleyways

Outstanding metal work will begin to be installed next week. Clawdd Du Ironwork supplier identified. Looking at end of summer for installation. Clawdd Du bin store will be free for businesses to use.

HSHAZ interim evaluation

Thorough evaluation work currently taking place. Second part of the evaluation will look at how the other four northern market towns can develop similar shopfront schemes. First draft due end of June. A bid has gone to the UK Shared Prosperity Fund (UKSPF) to extend the Oswestry project for another year.

Shopfront Guide

First draft due end of June. Positive document celebrating Oswestry's unique characteristics, contributions from local businesses and Civic Society. The guide will go to SC for adoption as a Supplementary Planning Document (SPD).

Cultural Consortium

Bid has gone to UKSPF to continue the Cultural Consortium for another year. Goal is to bring in an external company to deliver another large scale event. Group is now well established and is planning ahead to the Summer of Art and Heritage Open Days 2023 (Creativity Unwrapped). Four artists in residence appointed. Greater awareness and promotion of group taking place. Need to seek future funding.

Llywd Mansion

Project team meeting fortnightly to work on five strands:

- 1) Acquisition by OTC
- 2) Laser study and engineering studies
- 3) Grant funding for urgent works (e.g. Buildings at Risk fund, Architectural Heritage schemes)
- 4) Replacing the harris fencing with wooden hoarding with photo/historic info wrapping
- 5) Future use

BWise building
